

Due West Preschool COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

- 1.) Morning temperature and health checks
- 2.) Keeping children with just their class (we will not combine classes for playground time or special classes to limit the amount of people they are exposed to)
- 3.) Parents will not come in the building at drop off or pick up times, for parties or to help teachers. (We will watch recommendations to lighten restriction as CDC and government health and safety requirements lessen)
- 4.) Teachers unloading and loading will wear masks and will hold children's wrists while helping them to and from cars and to classrooms
- 5.) We will have a children's meet and greet outside and teachers will do their Parent orientations online
- 6.) New policies will be in place on when your child can return to school after they have been sick, exposed to the Corona Virus, traveled out of the country or are recovering from the virus
- 7.) Hand washing as the children arrive, before meals, after using the bathroom, after playing on the playground, and as needed throughout the day.
- 8.) A room to isolate children who are sick until parents can arrive to take them home.
- 9.) Smocks or men's button down shirts, which can be changed in the ones and twos classes between holding of children to comfort or help them.
- 10.) Carline will be at different doors for different age groups to keep large groups from gathering. We will have a specific plan for carpools and siblings.
- 11.) Cleaning of tables, chairs, sinks, shelving and toys ongoing all day and at the end of the day with bleach, Lysol and Clorox wipes, and cleaning sprays that kill 99.9% of germs (to spray and leave on surfaces)
- 12.) One class on a playground at a time and using alternate spaces on campus to allow the cleaning of surfaces between classes.
- 13.) Wiping down bathrooms between classes and after individual children use them. Wiping down public spaces like light switches, railings and doors daily.
- 14.) Children will use their own supplies or supplies will be disinfected between users
- 15.) Mask will be not be required for children or teachers in the classroom but you are welcomed to send your child in one and we will do our best to have them wear it.
