




- Today is the **third** Sunday after Pentecost.

**One symbol for Pentecost is a tree.**




**Can you make your body look like a tree?

Look around your church. What are some important parts of your worship space? Is there a cross? A baptismal font? An altar? Below is a space for you to design your own church. Remember to include people, too!







Different climates grow different kinds of trees. Draw what trees might look like in each of these places:




BEACH IN FLORIDA






