



## **WE'RE HAVING COMMUNION!**

**Sunday April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020** we will be having Communion in Kid's Church for the kids who are ready.

**Here's how you can know if your child is ready:**

(References: 1 Corinthians 11, Matthew 26:26-27)

They have accepted Jesus as their Savior.

They understand that we sin, and that sin separates us from God. Jesus died on the cross to take the punishment for our sin. If we understand that and accept his forgiveness we are forgiven. Now we are free from sin and live for Jesus.

They understand what the emblems mean:

The bread/cracker represents Jesus' body that was broken for us.

The grape juice represents Jesus' blood that was shed to forgive our sins.

They understand that we are taking Communion to remember what Jesus has done for us.

They can wait (even with your help) and take it all together as a group.

If your child is not ready, that's ok! Have them listen along with us. We're a team and we will celebrate with you on the day they are ready!

Do not allow them to participate if they are not ready. The Bible warns us against taking communion the wrong way. (verse 27)
