My Dad taught me how to play chess when I was about eight years old. I quickly learned to love the strategy of the game, deciphering which move is best, discerning what my opponent is planning, and developing my plan of attack. How can I move my pieces, maybe even sacrifice a pawn or two, so that I can checkmate the king (that's how you win in chess)?

While I've occasionally played chess at family gatherings and just as infrequently with friends throughout the years, I was never serious about chess. To me, chess was a game and something that I did for fun whenever I felt like it.

Then about a year ago, I decided to download the "chess.com" app on my phone. Immediately I was one of over 100 million users on the Internet's most popular chess platform, connected with players from across God's beautiful creation. I found myself having matches against people from countries like Brazil, Ireland, Pakistan, and Russia, as well as against players from countries that I've never heard of like Seychelles and Azerbaijan (to date, I've competed against players from 154 of 241 possible countries).

I quickly learned that if I wanted to be serious about this timeless game, then I had a lot to learn. I found myself watching YouTube videos from grandmasters, solving chess puzzles, and playing hundreds and hundreds of games in order to improve. A year later – and over 4,000 games later – I'm now ranked in the 93<sup>rd</sup> percentile of all chess players in the world. Sounds impressive, until I realize that there are more than 1.4 million active players that are ranked higher than me.

What I've also realized over this past year is that chess is a lot like our Christian discipleship. There are good days and there are bad days. There are days when I'm seeing the board clearly and making brilliant moves that lead to winning against higher-ranked opponents, and then there are days that I'm losing multiple games in a row, often as a result of "blundering." A blunder – as a result of my poor decision – is a very bad move in chess that severely worsens the player's position by allowing loss of material (a chess piece) or being checkmated, i.e., losing.

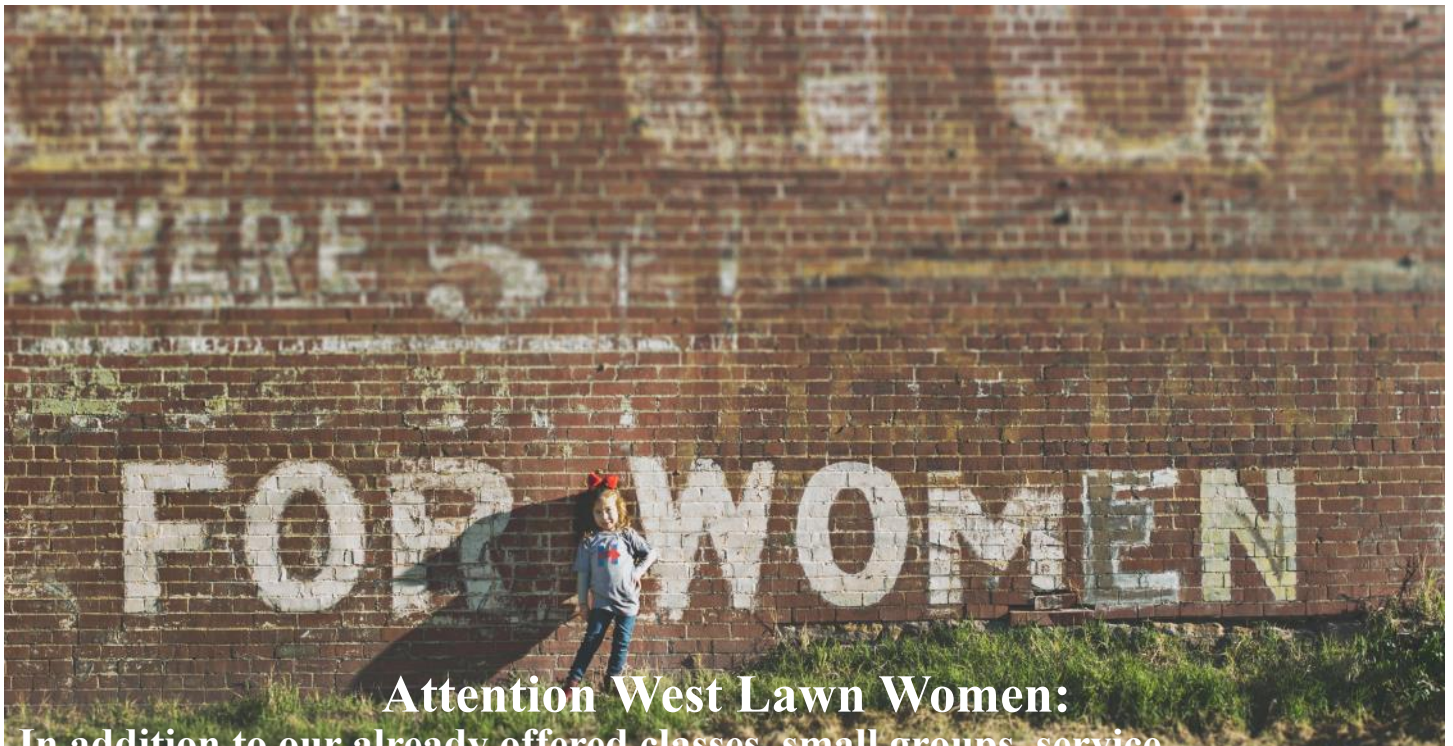
Much like in our personal discipleship, the more intentional we are about improving, the better our results will be. The more focused and attentive I am, and the more frequently I challenge myself by learning new things, the more favorable the outcomes will be. Will I still blunder and lose games? Absolutely. But when I'm committed to growing as a chess player, the more I'm able to overcome the slumps and even the plateaus and take my game to the next level. I believe this to be true in chess, and in our walk with Jesus.

The more time that we are spending in worship on a Sunday morning, and the more time we are in prayer with God or attending a Bible study with other Christians, or taking time to serve others or reading Christian literature – amongst many, many other things that we could be doing – the more we will grow in our faith. Conversely, if we neglect to do those things, our spiritual life slumps and we begin to blunder in life.

Whether it be chess or our faith, if we want to grow and "get better," then we need to be intentional about it. Each day we can do something that contributes to our personal discipleship and thereby brings God's kingdom a little closer to fruition... *"on earth as it is in heaven."*

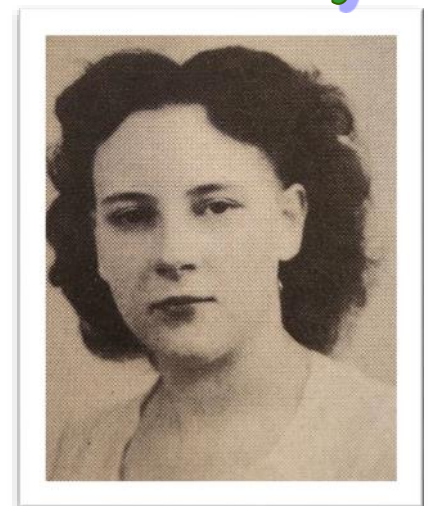
## Burial Plots For Sale

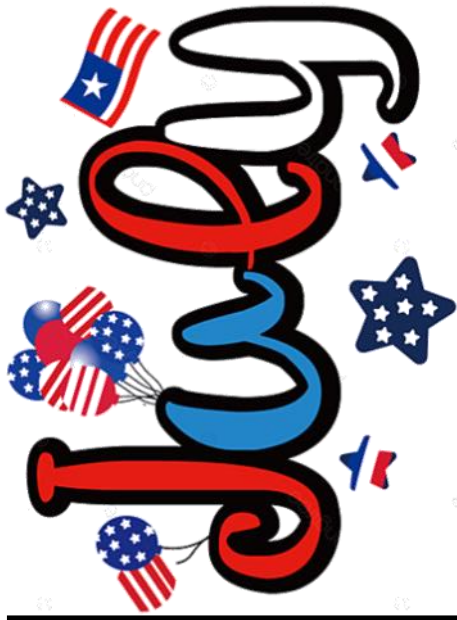
