Q: When you think of the word "Apocalypse", what comes to mind?

Q: How do "we" receive "Revelation"?

READ: Luke 10:21-24 "In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. ²² All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him." ²³ Then turning to the disciples he said privately, "Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! ²⁴ For I tell you that many prophets and kings desired to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it."

Q: What sticks out to you in this passage?

Q: According to verse 21, what metaphor does Jesus use and why?

Q: What would that indicate as necessary/important for us to have "revelation"?

Q: According to verse 22, "what" has been "handed over" to Jesus? Why is this significant?

Q: According to verse 22, what is NECESSARY IF you are to "see"?

Q: According to verses 23-24, what is the blessing? Why is THIS a blessing?

READ: Romans 10:17 "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."

Q: According to this verse, "how" does revelation happen? This is why "every day" is important!
