Opening Prayer

Q: How's the Daily Bible Reading Plan going?

READ: Acts 3:1-10 "Now Peter and John were going up to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour. ²And a man lame from birth was being carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple that is called the Beautiful Gate to ask alms of those entering the temple. ³Seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple, he asked to receive alms. ⁴And Peter directed his gaze at him, as did John, and said, "Look at us." ⁵And he fixed his attention on them, expecting to receive something from them. ⁶But Peter said, "I have no silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk!" ⁷And he took him by the right hand and raised him up, and immediately his feet and ankles were made strong. ⁸And leaping up, he stood and began to walk, and entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God. ⁹And all the people saw him walking and praising God, ¹⁰and recognized him as the one who sat at the Beautiful Gate of the temple, asking for alms. And they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him.

Q: In our text this lame man was begging. What was he hoping to receive from Peter and John? What did he get?

Q: How have you seen God do this in your life? (Give you MORE than you ask for)

Q: In our Acts 2 (Acts 2:22) readings this week, we learned how the "miracles", "signs and wonders", "attested to WHO Jesus IS! So, how does THIS miracle "attest" to who Peter and John is? How is it the same for us? (Hint: John 13:35)

Q: How can we as parents demonstrate this to our kids and integrate that into the "culture" of our family?

Q: How is faith "caught" AND "taught"? How does this also correspond to the ENGAGE study, session 1 where we see the need for different inputs in order for our child's brains to develop properly?

Q: What's ONE way you can help your kids "catch" faith this week and give them "MORE"?

NOTE: Our kids will be making "Blessing Bags" for panhandlers/homeless folks today. This is an opportunity for them to give MORE and to remember to pray for those in need. We are hoping they will get excited about blessing them and what a wonderful way to keep this idea in front of them: Jesus gives us MORE than we think we need/want!

Sunday, Apr 18, 2021 Acts 3:1-10 #27 "What I DO Have, I Give"

Q: What is it like when you are able to "give" to someone who is asking?

Q: How did the lame man, receive MORE than he asked?

Q: How have you seen God do that in YOUR life?

Monday, Apr 19, 2021 Acts 3:11-16 "By Faith In His Name"

Q: Who did Peter give the credit too for this man's healing?

Q: According to verse 16, "how" was this man healed?

Q: How did this man's healing effect others?

Tuesday, Apr 20, 2021 Acts 3:17-26 "Times of Refreshing"

Q: What was Peter's invitation/command in verse 19? Why is this important?

Q: According to verse 26, what did God do and what is the result?

Q: How can we experience/do this in our life?

Wednesday, Apr 21, 2021 Acts 4:1-4 "5000"

Q: What did the religious leaders do in response to Peter's message?

Q: Do you think everyone will like that you follow Jesus? Why or why not?

Q: According to verse 4, how many DID respond in a positive way? How is that incredible?

Thursday, Apr 22, 2021 Acts 4:5-12 "Salvation In No-one Else"

Q: What did Peter say to the religious leaders? Who is he talking to them about?

Q: According to verse 12, Peter says something about Jesus. What is it?

Q: How can WE be better witnesses to Jesus so others know HE is the One Who saves?

Friday, Apr 23, 2021 Acts 4:13-22 "Can't Help It"

Q: What did the religious leaders notice about Peter and John?

Q: What does this tell us about how God is able to use US?

Q: In verse 20, Peter says something. What is it and how can WE learn from it?

Saturday, Apr 24, 2021 Acts 4:23-31 "Boldness"

Q: What were the believes praying for?

Q: Why is boldness important?
