#### God

#### Kairos time

- Luke 4:18-19 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He anointed Me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim release to captives, And recovery of sight to the blind, To set free those who are oppressed, <sup>19</sup> To proclaim the favorable year of the Lord."
- Mark 1:15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."
- Acts 1:6-8 So, when they had come together, they began asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time that You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?" <sup>7</sup> But He said to them, "It is not for you to know periods of time or appointed times which the Father has set by His own authority; <sup>8</sup> but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and as far as the remotest part of the earth."

## Faithful

o 1 Cor 2:9-10 but just as it is written:

"Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard,

And which have not entered the human heart,

All that God has prepared for those who love Him.

- <sup>10</sup> For to us God revealed *them* through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.
- 1 Cor 2:12 Now we have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God.
- Is 55:11 So will My word be which goes out of My mouth; It will not return to Me empty,
   Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding in the purpose for which I sent it

- Fear of the Lord
  - Psalm 33:8 Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.
  - Prov 9:10 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
- Walking in the authority of the believer/Not afraid of taking risks
  - Matt 28:18-20 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. <sup>19</sup> Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to follow all that I commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
  - Mark 8:35 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it.
  - Eph 2:4-10 But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our wrongdoings, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), <sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus, <sup>7</sup> so that in the ages to come He might show the boundless riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. <sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith; and this *is* not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.
  - Is 54:17 No weapon that is formed against you will succeed;
     And you will condemn every tongue that accuses you in judgment.
     This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their vindication is from Me," declares the Lord.
  - John 16:33 But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.
- Understanding the times (Sons of Issachar)
  - 1 Chron 12:32 From the sons of Issachar, men who understood the times, with knowledge of what Israel should do, their chiefs were two hundred; and all their kinsmen were at their command.
  - Dan 2:20-22 Daniel said, "May the name of God be blessed forever and ever,
     For wisdom and power belong to Him. <sup>21</sup> It is He who changes the times and the periods;
     He removes kings and appoints kings; He gives wisdom to wise men, And knowledge to people
     of understanding.<sup>22</sup> It is He who reveals the profound and hidden things; He knows what is in
     the darkness, And the light dwells with Him.
  - 2 Cor 6:1-2 And working together with Him, we also urge you not to receive the grace of God in vain—<sup>2</sup> for He says, "At a favorable time I listened to you, And on a day of salvation I helped you. "Behold, now is "a favorable time," behold, now is "a day of salvation"—

- O 1 Cor 2:7,9,10 <sup>7</sup> but we speak God's wisdom in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God predestined before the ages to our glory; <sup>9</sup> but just as it is written: "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, And which have not entered the human heart, All that God has prepared for those who love Him." <sup>10</sup> For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.
- o Is 26:3-4 The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, Because he trusts in You. ⁴ Trust in the Lord forever, For in God the Lord, we have an everlasting Rock.

- o John 14:27 <sup>27</sup> Peace I leave you, My peace I give you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, nor [b] fearful.

## Declaration of His promises

- Psalm 96:3 Tell of His glory among the nations, His wonderful deeds among all the peoples.
- Psalm 40:5 Many, Lord my God, are the wonders which You have done, And Your thoughts toward us; There is no one to compare with You. If I would declare and speak of them, They would be too numerous to count.
- Rom 4:20-21 <sup>20</sup> yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, <sup>21</sup> and being fully assured that what *God* had promised, He was able also to perform.

# Worship

#### • Worship is warfare

- 2 Chron 20:21-22 <sup>21</sup> When he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who sang to the Lord and those who praised *Him* in holy attire, as they went out before the army and said, "Give thanks to the Lord, for His faithfulness is everlasting." <sup>22</sup> When they began singing and praising, the Lord set ambushes against the sons of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; so they were struck down.
- O Psalm 149 <sup>1</sup>Praise the Lord! Sing a new song to the Lord, *And* His praise in the congregation of the godly ones. <sup>2</sup> Israel shall be joyful in his Maker; The sons of Zion shall rejoice in their King. <sup>3</sup> They shall praise His name with dancing; They shall sing praises to Him with tambourine and lyre. <sup>4</sup> For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will glorify the lowly with salvation. <sup>5</sup> The godly ones shall be jubilant in glory; They shall sing for joy on their beds. <sup>6</sup> The high praises of God *shall be* in their mouths, And a two edged sword in their hands, <sup>7</sup> To execute vengeance on the nations, And punishment on the peoples, <sup>8</sup> To bind their kings with chains, And their dignitaries with shackles of iron, <sup>9</sup> To execute against them the judgment written. This is an honor for all His godly ones. Praise the Lord!

- Tears down barriers and strongholds; brings unity and dominion
  - O Dan 6:26-27 <sup>26</sup> I issue a decree that in all the realm of my kingdom people are to tremble and fear before the God of Daniel; For He is the living God and enduring forever, And His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed, And His dominion will be forever. <sup>27</sup> He rescues, saves, and performs signs and miracles In heaven and on earth, He who has also rescued Daniel from the power of the lions.
  - Eph 2:13-16 <sup>13</sup> But now in Christ Jesus you who previously were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. <sup>14</sup> For He Himself is our peace, who made both *groups into* one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall, <sup>15</sup> by abolishing in His flesh the hostility, which is the Law composed of commandments expressed in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two one new person, in this way establishing peace; <sup>16</sup> and that He might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the hostility.
  - O Psalm 133 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brothers to live together in unity! <sup>2</sup> It is like the precious oil on the head, Running down upon the beard, *As on* Aaron's beard, *The oil* which ran down upon the edge of his robes. <sup>3</sup> It is like the dew of Hermon Coming down upon the mountains of Zion; For the Lord commanded the blessing there—life forever.
- Embracing His Kingdom by making Him central
  - Psalm 27:4 One thing I have asked from the Lord, that I shall seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the Lord And to meditate in His temple.
  - Rom 12:1 Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.
  - 2 Cor 10:4 for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses.
- Outpouring of the anointing
  - Matt 10:8 Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, cast out demons. Freely you
    received, freely give.
  - Psalm 23:5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;
     You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.
  - 1 John 2:24-28 *As for* you, *see that* what you heard from the beginning remains in you. If what you heard from the beginning remains in you, you also will remain in the Son and in the Father.

    <sup>25</sup> This is the promise which He Himself made to us: eternal life. <sup>26</sup> These things I have written to you concerning those who are *trying to* deceive you. <sup>27</sup> And *as for* you, the anointing which you received from Him remains in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you remain in Him.
  - Acts 1:7-9 But He said to them, "It is not for you to know periods of time or appointed times
    which the Father has set by His own authority; but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit
    has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem and in all Judea,
    and Samaria, and as far as the remotest part of the earth."

O 1 Cor 12:6-11 There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons. <sup>7</sup> But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. <sup>8</sup> For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; <sup>9</sup> to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, <sup>10</sup> and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues. <sup>11</sup> But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

## Intimacy & God's presence

- o Psalm 22:3 Yet You are holy, You who are enthroned upon the praises of Israel.
- Psalm 139:1-18 Lord, You have searched me and known me. <sup>2</sup> You know when I sit down and when I get up; You understand my thought from far away. <sup>3</sup> You scrutinize my path and my lying down, And are acquainted with all my ways. <sup>4</sup> Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, Lord, You know it all. 5 You have encircled me behind and in front, And placed Your hand upon me. <sup>6</sup> Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is too high, I cannot comprehend it. <sup>7</sup> Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? 8 If I ascend to heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in Sheol, behold, You are there. <sup>9</sup> If I take up the wings of the dawn, If I dwell in the remotest part of the sea, <sup>10</sup> Even there Your hand will lead me, And Your right hand will take hold of me. <sup>11</sup> If I say, "Surely the darkness will overwhelm me, And the light around me will be night," <sup>12</sup> Even darkness is not dark to You, And the night is as bright as the day. Darkness and light are alike to You. 13 For You created my innermost parts; You wove me in my mother's womb. 14 I will give thanks to You, because I am awesomely and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well. 15 My frame was not hidden from You When I was made in secret, And skillfully formed in the depths of the earth; <sup>16</sup> Your eyes have seen my formless substance; And in Your book were written All the days that were ordained for me, When as yet there was not one of them. 17 How precious also are Your thoughts for me, God! How vast is the sum of them! <sup>18</sup> Were I to count them, they would outnumber the sand. When I awake, I am still with You.

# **Testimony**

- Tell our story inside and outside the church building
  - Acts 4:33 And with great power the apostles were giving testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and abundant grace was upon them all.
  - O Psalm 18 "I love You, Lord, my strength." <sup>2</sup>The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my savior, My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. <sup>3</sup>I call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, And I am saved from my enemies. <sup>4</sup>The ropes of death encompassed me, And the torrents of destruction terrified me. <sup>5</sup>The ropes of Sheol surrounded me; The snares of death confronted me. <sup>6</sup>In my distress I called upon the Lord, And cried to my God for help; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry for help before Him came into His ears. <sup>7</sup>Then the earth shook and quaked; And the foundations of the mountains were trembling And were shaken, because He was angry. <sup>8</sup>Smoke went up [e]out of His nostrils, And fire from His mouth was devouring; Coals burned

from it. <sup>9</sup> He also bowed the heavens down low, and came down With thick darkness under His feet. <sup>10</sup> He rode on a cherub and flew; And He sped on the wings of the wind. <sup>11</sup> He made darkness His hiding place, His canopy around Him, Darkness of waters, thick clouds. <sup>12</sup> From the brightness before Him passed His thick clouds, Hailstones and coals of fire. <sup>13</sup> The Lord also thundered in the heavens, And the Most High uttered His voice, Hailstones and coals of fire. <sup>14</sup> He sent out His arrows, and scattered them, And lightning flashes in abundance, and [g]routed them. 15 Then the channels of water appeared, And the foundations of the world were exposed By Your rebuke, Lord, At the blast of the breath of Your nostrils. <sup>16</sup> He sent from on high, He took me; He drew me out of many waters. <sup>17</sup> He saved me from my strong enemy, And from those who hated me, for they were too mighty for me. <sup>18</sup> They confronted me in the day of my disaster, But the Lord was my support. <sup>19</sup> He also brought me out into an open place; He rescued me, because He delighted in me. <sup>20</sup> The Lord has rewarded me according to my righteousness; According to the cleanness of my hands He has repaid me. <sup>21</sup> For I have kept the ways of the Lord, And have not acted wickedly against my God. <sup>22</sup> For all His judgments were before me, And I did not put away His statutes from me. <sup>23</sup> I was also blameless with Him, And I kept myself from my wrongdoing. <sup>24</sup> Therefore the Lord has repaid me according to my righteousness, According to the cleanness of my hands in His eyes. <sup>25</sup> With the faithful You show Yourself faithful; With the blameless You prove Yourself blameless; <sup>26</sup> With the pure You show Yourself pure, And with the crooked You show Yourself astute. <sup>27</sup> For You save an afflicted people, But You humiliate haughty eyes. <sup>28</sup> For You light my lamp; The Lord my God illumines my darkness. <sup>29</sup> For by You I can run at a troop of warriors; And by my God I can leap over a wall. 30 As for God, His way is blameless; The word of the Lord is refined; He is a shield to all who take refuge in Him. 31 For who is God, but the Lord? And who is a rock, except our God, <sup>32</sup> The God who encircles me with strength, And makes my way blameless? <sup>33</sup> He makes my feet like deer's feet, And sets me up on my high places. <sup>34</sup> He trains my hands for battle, So that my arms can bend a bow of bronze. 35 You have also given me the shield of Your salvation, And Your right hand upholds me; And Your gentleness makes me great. <sup>36</sup> You enlarge my steps under me, And my feet have not slipped. <sup>37</sup> I pursued my enemies and overtook them, And I did not turn back until they were consumed. <sup>38</sup> I shattered them, so that they were not able to rise; They fell under my feet. <sup>39</sup> For You have encircled me with strength for battle; You have forced those who rose up against me to bow down under me. 40 You have also made my enemies turn their backs to me, And I destroyed those who hated me. 41 They cried for help, but there was no one to save, They cried to the Lord, but He did not answer them. <sup>42</sup>Then I beat them fine like the dust before the wind; I emptied them out like the mud of the streets. <sup>43</sup> You have rescued me from the contentions of the people; You have placed me as head of the nations; A people whom I have not known serve me. <sup>44</sup> As soon as they hear, they obey me; Foreigners pretend to obey me. <sup>45</sup> Foreigners lose heart, And come trembling out of their fortresses. <sup>46</sup> The Lord lives, and blessed be my rock; And exalted be the God of my salvation, <sup>47</sup> The God who executes vengeance for me, And subdues peoples under me. <sup>48</sup> He rescues me from my enemies; You indeed lift me above those who rise up against me; You rescue me from a violent man. <sup>49</sup> Therefore I will give thanks to You among the nations, Lord, And I will sing praises to Your name. <sup>50</sup> He gives great salvation to His king, And shows faithfulness to His anointed, To David and his descendants forever.

- Attract others to the goodness of God
  - Rev 12:11 And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word
    of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.
  - Psalm 40 I waited patiently for the Lord; And He reached down to me and heard my cry. <sup>2</sup> He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the mud; And He set my feet on a rock, making my footsteps firm. <sup>3</sup> He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God; Many will see and fear And will trust in the Lord. <sup>4</sup> How blessed is the man who has made the Lord his trust, And has not turned to the proud, nor to those who become involved in falsehood. <sup>5</sup> Many, Lord my God, are the wonders which You have done, And Your thoughts toward us; There is no one to compare with You. If I would declare and speak of them, They would be too numerous to count. <sup>6</sup> You have not desired sacrifice and meal offering; You have opened my ears; You have not required burnt offering and sin offering. <sup>7</sup> Then I said, "Behold, I have come; It is written of me in the scroll of the book. 8 I delight to do Your will, my God; Your Law is within my heart." 9 I have proclaimed good news of righteousness in the great congregation; Behold, I will not restrain my lips, Lord, You know. 10 I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart; I have spoken of Your faithfulness and Your salvation; I have not concealed Your mercy and Your truth from the great congregation. <sup>11</sup> You, Lord, will not withhold Your compassion from me; Your mercy and Your truth will continually watch over me. <sup>12</sup> For evils beyond number have surrounded me; My guilty deeds have overtaken me, so that I am not able to see; They are more numerous than the hairs of my head, And my heart has failed me. <sup>13</sup> Be pleased, Lord, to rescue me; Hurry, Lord, to help me. <sup>14</sup> May those be ashamed and humiliated together Who seek my life to destroy it; May those be turned back and dishonored Who delight in my hurt. <sup>15</sup> May those be appalled because of their shame Who say to me, "Aha, aha!" 16 May all who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; May those who love Your salvation continually say, "The Lord be exalted!" <sup>17</sup> But I am afflicted and needy; May the Lord be mindful of me. You are my help and my savior; Do not delay, my God.
- Builds faith for salvation, healing and deliverance
  - Psalm 19:7 The Law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the soul;
     The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.
  - Matt 24:14 This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come.
  - Acts 8:5-7 Philip went down to the city of Samaria and began proclaiming the Christ to them. <sup>6</sup> The crowds were paying attention with one mind to what was being said by Philip, as they heard and saw the signs which he was performing. <sup>7</sup> For in the case of many who had unclean spirits, they were coming out of them shouting with a loud voice; and many who had been paralyzed or limped on crutches were healed.
  - Acts 14:3 Therefore they spent a long time there speaking boldly with reliance upon the Lord, who was testifying to the word of His grace, granting that signs and wonders be performed by their hands.

## Authority to speak

- Mark 16:19-20 So then, when the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.<sup>20</sup> And they went out and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with *them*, and confirmed the word by the signs that followed.]
- Matt 10:7-8 And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' <sup>8</sup> Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give.
- 1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for *God's* own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; <sup>10</sup> for you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

## **Revival/Awakening**

- River of God & Living Water
  - o Ez 47:1-5 Then he brought me back to the door of the house; and behold, water was flowing from under the threshold of the house toward the east, for the house faced east. And the water was flowing down from under, from the right side of the house, from south of the altar. <sup>2</sup> And he brought me out by way of the north gate and led me around on the outside to the outer gate, by the way facing east. And behold, water was spurting out from the south side. <sup>3</sup> When the man went out toward the east with a line in his hand, he measured a thousand cubits, and he led me through the water, water *reaching* the ankles. <sup>4</sup> Again he measured a thousand and led me through the water, water *reaching* the knees. Again he measured a thousand and led me through *the water*, water *reaching* the hips. <sup>5</sup> Again he measured a thousand; *and it was* a river that I could not wade across, because the water had risen, *enough* water to swim in, a river that could not be crossed *by wading*.
  - John 7:38 The one who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'"
- God's will be a stronghold to the city and the nation
  - o Prov 18:10 The name of the Lord is a strong tower; The righteous runs into it and is safe.
  - Is 2:1-3 Now it will come about that In the last days The mountain of the house of the Lord Will be established as the chief of the mountains, And will be raised above the hills; And all the nations will stream to it. <sup>3</sup> And many peoples will come and say, "Come, let's go up to the mountain of the Lord,
    - To the house of the God of Jacob; So that He may teach us about His ways, And that we may walk in His paths." For the law will go out from Zion And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.
- Repentance, Transformation, Restoration, Reconciliation, Redemption
  - Rom 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
  - 2 Cor 3:18 But we all, with unveiled faces, looking as in a mirror at the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

- 2 Cor 5:17-19 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, this person is a new creation; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.<sup>18</sup> Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation,<sup>19</sup> namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their wrongdoings against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation.
- 2 Peter 3:8-10 But do not let this one fact escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day. <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not willing for any to perish, but for all to come to repentance. <sup>10</sup> But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be discovered.
- Eph 3:16-19 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner self,<sup>17</sup> so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup> may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and height and depth, <sup>19</sup> and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled to all the fullness of God.
