

City Church COVID-19 UPDATE

City Church is currently running its Tuesday Prayer and Sunday services at 25% capacity with social distancing. We want to assure you that we are doing our best to make sure the church is a safe place for everyone and are taking that into consideration in how we hold services, events and activities.

At this time, we plan to continue to live stream the 6:30PM Tuesday Prayer service and the 8:30AM + 11AM worship services on Sundays on our website and Facebook in addition to having services in the church building.

ON SUNDAYS:

Services will be held in the sanctuary each week at 8:30AM + 11AM. The Sunday services will be limited to 25% of our sanctuary capacity (including all attendees and volunteers).

We are currently not holding a Sunday PM service other than our monthly Worshiping & Waiting service. Please see the calendar on our website events page for information on those services.

We have some things you need to know when you attend a City Church service:

- The church building will be open 30 minutes prior to the service start time.
- You do not need to sign up ahead of time for the service.
- There will be social distancing and health measures in place such as spaced out seating, no greeting time during the service, etc. We ask that all those present please adhere to these measures. Please read the COVID-19 social distancing and health guidelines listed on the next page before coming to church.
- There will be no food or coffee available at the church building. We encourage you to bring your own coffee/beverage in a container with a lid.
- We are holding Kids Church during the 11AM service. See below for more information.

Sunday AM Children's Ministry (11AM only):

We are currently holding Kids Church during the 11AM service. here is also a Zoom virtual option available for Kids Church. Contact Jan Babler at the church to receive the Zoom link each week. There is no early Childhood Care (nursery) at this time

ON TUESDAYS:

Tuesday evening prayer meeting will be held at 6:30PM in the sanctuary. The prayer meeting will be limited to 25% of our sanctuary capacity (including all attendees and volunteers). The policies and procedures listed above for Sunday services, will also be in effect for our Tuesday prayer meeting.

OTHER CITY CHURCH ACTIVITIES + EVENTS:

City Church is holding activities and events based on the current Madison & Dane County Health regulations. City Church COVID-19 social distancing & HEALTH guidelines

BEFORE COMING TO CITY CHURCH:

- If you are a part of those classified as “vulnerable” for COVID-19, we encourage you to stay home and participate through our live stream.
- If you are unwell, please stay home and recuperate fully before coming to City Church.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 or you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please stay home for 14 days from the onset of your symptoms or the last contact with the person who tested positive. For a definition of “close contact” go to: Definition of close contact according to public health.
- In accordance with the recommendations of national and local health officials if you have returned from domestic or international travel from location with a travel ban, please wait for 14 days after your return (to ensure you are not sick) before coming to City Church. For more information go to: CDC Travel Guidelines
- In accordance with the current State of Wisconsin and Madison & Dane County Health orders, masks should be worn indoors.

WHEN AT CITY CHURCH:

- When you are at the church building, please regularly wash or sanitize your hands.
- Before, during, and after services, please maintain social distancing of 6 feet between yourself and others not in your family.
- Please sit in designated pews/chairs to help with social distancing. Families are allowed to sit together in one pew, but we ask that the 6 ft. social distancing rule be observed with non-family members.
- Please do all talking/fellowshipping before and after the service outside the church building. Please do not congregate in groups in the hallways, stairwells, and foyers. We also ask that you adhere to social distancing guidelines while on the City Church grounds.
- There will be no food or coffee available at the church building. You are welcome to bring your own coffee/beverage in a container with a lid, but please do not bring any food into the building.
- On the first Sunday of the month when we have communion, we will be providing pre-packed individual communion sets. If you are uncomfortable with touching or using the provided communion sets, we ask that you bring your own communion elements with you to the church service.
- Because we will be disinfecting/cleaning the church building between services, we ask that people exit the building quickly so that we have ample time to do this between services.
