On your first visit, your child will receive a blue University Heights Kid's slap bracelet to wear and keep when they check-in at our Children's Welcome Desk on the second floor of our Kids' Building. This will let our teachers know that this is your child's first visit. Our staff and team of volunteers recognize these bracelets and will go above and beyond in helping your child feel right at home from the start.

We know that nothing is as important as the safety and security of every child. God has entrusted us with caring for your children and we are humbled by this privilege. Here are some of the things we do to keep your kids safe and secure.

- Secure check-in for every child. Please view "Secure Check-In" for instructions on how to check your child in and out.
- Our Preschool and Children's building is securely locked and only those with a security tag or accompanied by a team member are allowed to enter.
- University Heights has trained security officers on campus who patrol the campus on Sunday mornings.
- Every staff member and volunteer has been screened by an outside investigation agency and passed a criminal background check.
