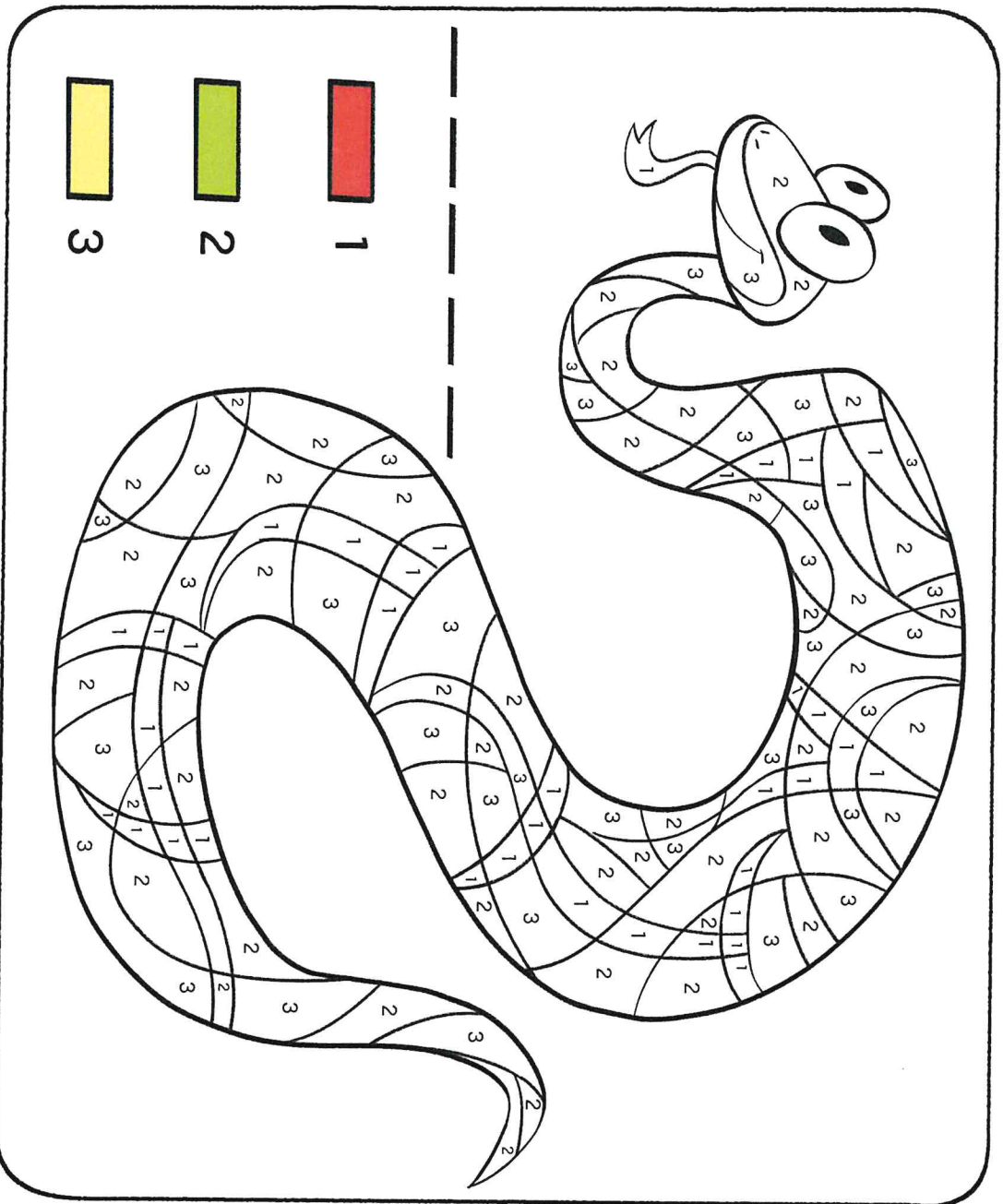


Sithering Snake

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- God's people continued to distrust Him and complain about the food He provided for them.
- To discipline them, God sent venomous snakes into their camps.
- The people cried out for God to save them.
- God told His people to look at the bronze snake to be healed.

KEY PASSAGE: Proverbs 3:5-6

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What does it mean to sin? To sin is to think, speak, or behave in any way that goes against God and His commands.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why was God good to discipline His people?
- How does the bronze snake remind us of Jesus?
- How are we similar to the Israelites?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Take your kids to a local zoo that has a reptile exhibit. Talk about the snakes living there. Remind your family that God was good to provide a way for the people to be healed from the snakebites.



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
