We have very exciting news to share about the ACC Kids C.L.U.B.! Over the past 6 months, we have been growing on Wednesday Nights and Sunday mornings! We are averaging 60 kids on Sunday mornings and 50 on Wednesday

nights! We are praising God as the kids in these programs are learning more about Jesus, how to worship, and how to serve! The past few weeks they have made crafts and mailed them to 50 of our church friends who have a harder time getting out. The kids loved it and keep asking what else we can do for them, so we are working on some things!

All of this growth and excitement is leaving us with growing pains in the kids wing. We need to fill our current Kids Club volunteer schedule, so we can begin adding classes at our 10:30 service! We need 7 more people to fill our current schedule, which needs 52 volunteers a month! When we meet that need, we hope to offer classes for birth-Kindergarten at 10:30; and eventually expand to our 1st-6th graders. Will you pray for God to provide more workers who will serve one time a month? Will you ask God if He could use you to play with the kids, help them be good listeners, and be a volunteer in the ACC Kids C.L.U.B.?
