We are so excited to be together in person as a church family! We have temporarily reconstructed our usual 8 & 10:15 am worship service schedule to four services at 8, 9, 10 and 11 am. Sunday School for all ages is now 10-10:45 am. Many safety measures are in place throughout the morning:

- —The building will be thoroughly cleaned between each service by our cleaning team
- —Volunteers and staff will open doors for you
- —We are asking families to sit with their family group and leave space between other family groups when seated
- —All helpful doors have been propped open or opened by our greeters and staff
- —Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building
- —Bulletins may be picked up from several locations
- —We will not be passing offering or communion trays but will have them available at the end of each service placed throughout the Worship Center
- —Overflow rooms in the youth room, kids' check-in area and lobby are available for viewing the service live on screens.
- —The high school room is set with tables, some color pages, and activities which may be more conducive for family worship. The service is live streamed to the high school room at the 8, 9, 10, and 11 services.

Applying Today's Sermon to Your Life

- Our 2020 sermon series is a Bible study of Jesus in the four Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Read Luke 2:8-14. What is your favorite sacred Christmas carol? Why? What memories return when you hear it? How does its words teach the Gospel?
- 2. To celebrate Jesus' birth, Luke started his Gospel with four songs! Read each one and explain who was singing and what was being celebrated:
 - A. Mary's song (Luke 1:46-56)
 - B. Zechariah's song (Luke 1:67-79)
 - C. Angels' song (Luke 2:14)
 - D. Simeon's song (Luke 2:28-32)
- 3. How does knowing that Jesus' birth and ministry was actually predicted centuries before it happened affect your life and your faith? Compare:
- A. Isaiah 9:7 to Luke 1:32-33
- B. Isaiah 53:12 to Matthew 27:38
- C. Zechariah 6:13 to Hebrews 7:24-25 What does all this tell you?
- 4. Answer the following as TRUE or FALSE:
 - T F Everyone knows the true meaning of Christmas.
 - T F Many are more receptive to the Gospel in this season.
 - T F My goal is to share the light of Christ with others.

Now think about your neighbors, your coworkers, your relatives, your classmates, your friends, and people in your circle of acquaintance. Who needs your touch, your outreach, your invitation? Will you pray, reach out, and invite this week?
