INTRODUCTION

Our 2021 Bible study is *The Gospel According to Paul*, from Acts 8-28 and Paul's letters: Romans, 1 & 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 & 2 Thessalonians, 1 & 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, and maybe Hebrews. Today's Bible study on Easter Sunday, from the resurrection chapter, surfaces The A-B-C's of Easter.


Thank you for worshipping with us today!

Applying Today's Sermon to Your Life

- 1. Our 2021 Bible study is *The Gospel According to Paul*, from the life and letters of the Apostle Paul in the New Testament. Paul's story starts in Acts 7:57-58, when, known as Saul, Paul is sponsoring the stoning of the evangelist, Stephen. Everything changed when Paul met Jesus in Acts 9! Have you, personally, met Jesus? If so, what has changed?
- 2. 1 Corinthians 15 is known as Paul's great resurrection chapter! Celebrate Easter by reading all 58 verses of this wonderful resurrection chapter, then you will discover the full meaning of this chapter's final verse! Read verse 58 before your Easter meal today. Commit this verse to memory and let's all obey it together!
- 3. Answer the following as True or False:
 - T F Good people don't have to worry about being forgiven.
- T F The message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing.
- T F The Living Jesus has changed the hearts and minds of millions.
- T F The resurrected Jesus appeared to hundreds as eyewitnesses.

- 5. Why did the Apostle Paul stress Christ's resurrection appearances in I Corinthians 15:5-8? Why is this still important?
- 6. Paul had started the church in the city of Corinth and he later wrote them two letters, I and 2 Corinthians, in our New Testament. Find time this week to read both letters. What was this church like? How did Paul address their troubles?
- 7. The church Paul planted in Corinth had some problems. What might this tell us? How many perfect churches exist? What would happen if you found a perfect church? If you joined the perfect church, wouldn't that mess it up for them?
- 8. Imagine living today without faith, without knowing Jesus, without knowing how to pray, and without a supportive church family. Now think about your neighbors, your coworkers, your relatives, your classmates, your friends, and people in your circle of acquaintance. Who needs your faith, your Jesus, your prayers, your church family? Will you pray, reach out, and invite this week?
