Not one person. Fight the urge to stay insider-focused by Going After the One! Several outreach projects have taken place this season to help you do so (doorknob hangers in Sunday bulletins, Christmas invitation/envelope on Sunday, November 22, and now a Christmas card/invitation mailed to every area home)! Let's fight the urge to stay insider-focused. Let's be inviting, warm and welcoming at every turn! Our annual Christmas Coffee & Pastries Fellowship is Sunday, December 20, 8:30-11:00am so bring your neighbors and friends as you come and go! Five 30-minute Christmas Eve Candlelight and Communion Services are Thursday, December 24, at 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, 5pm and 6pm for your neighbors, classmates, coworkers, relatives, friends and enemies this Christmas season! People will come to church at Christmas if you invite them!

We host four 30-minute worship services every Sunday: traditional at 8am and 9am, contemporary at 10am and 11am. If the Worship Center feels too full, our large Youth Room shows all four services on a big screen in real-time. Families sit together. Ministers wear masks. Communion and offering is provided but not passed. There are no handshakes. Sunday bulletins are available or you can print your own from our website. Custodians provide real-time cleaning. Worship is online at 9am and 11am, live-streamed on our app, or later on YouTube. Sunday school classes for all ages are from 10:00-10:45! A free, updated copy of our pictorial directory will soon be available for every family and friend of ACC to help us worship, connect and serve even better!

Our Angel Tree will be in the foyer November 29 - December 13, thanks to Jackie Hines and Cathy Wiseman.

Next season's Wednesday Night Connection is being planned for January 13 - March 24!

Our leaders continue working with Logic Board (logicboard.org) to put all of ACC's procedures, practices, protocols and policies in writing, much as they did in Acts 15. This process requires Bible study, discernment, and getting it in writing for continuity, unity, and striving toward our mission in harmony. Our concern is not only the church of the present, but the church of the future!

This effort will reduce business meetings and increase ministry!

Run The Race (Hebrews 12:1-3) is our current giving effort reducing our debt in 2020-2022 with (1) prayer, (2) new commitments, (3) continued or increased commitments, (4) 100 people giving \$5 weekly, or (5) a building payment. It's all for Jesus!




