

MAKE ME A SERVANT

What does it mean to be a servant and what does loving service look like?

In Philippians 2: 3-5, Paul challenges us to have the attitude of Jesus by putting other people before ourselves and our desires. In John 13: 3-5, Jesus provided a wonderful example for us by doing one of the lowliest tasks- washing the feet of His friends. This was their teacher and mentor, the Son of God Himself lovingly washing the dirt from their feet. This included Judas who would later betray Him. Imagine that! Serving someone who isn't going to be nice back to you!

While we may think of servants as less because they are tasked with doing the hard or unpleasant jobs that others do not do, Jesus said it's the opposite. Matthew 23:11-12 says Jesus tells us that to be a servant of others is what makes us great. This is loving service to do for others for their good and not our own glory.
