



Philip Teaches an Ethiopian Man

Acts 8:26-40

(Point to the man in the picture)

Let's wave and ask this man what he's doing.

(Say to the rhythm of, "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?")

Hey there!

Hey there!

What are you doing?

I'm reading God's Word!

(In normal speaking rhythm)

The man from far away was reading God's Word, just like we are!



(Point to the man)

This is Philip. Let's ask him what he sees.

(Say to the rhythm of, "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?")

Philip,

Philip,

What do you see?

I see an angel talking to me!

(In normal speaking rhythm)

God sent an angel to tell Philip to find the man from far away.

Let's move our arms like we're running to go find the man. (Everyone will move their arms as if they are running)



(Point to Philip)

Philip found him! Let's ask Philip what he hears.

(Say to the rhythm of, "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?")

Philip,

Philip,

What do you hear?

I hear the man reading God's Word!

(In normal speaking rhythm)

The man from far away was reading God's Word, the Bible.



Let's ask the man from far away if he needs help.

(Say to the rhythm of, "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?")

Hey there!

Hey there!

Do you need help?

Yes! I do need help.

(In normal speaking rhythm)

The man did not understand, and he needed someone to help him.

Philip helped the man understand what he was reading in the Bible.



Let's ask Philip what they learned from the Bible.

(Say to the rhythm of, "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?")

Philip,

Philip,

What did you learn?

We learned that the Bible is God's words to us and that God loves us so much!

(In normal speaking rhythm)

You and I can get quiet and read God's Word, too! Let me hear you say this after me! (PAUSE to allow kids to repeat)

Read (make book with hands)

God's Word (both hands point up)
