Need to Know: God Tells Me to Obey **Bible Story:** The Ten Commandments

Bible Reference: Exodus 19:1-20:17, Deuteronomy 26:16-19



CIRCLE UP

DO

- Welcome kids to church and tell them who you are.
- Show the **horse** and say: "This little horsey wants to say, "Howdy," to each of you! When it comes to you, wave hello!"
- Sanitize kids' hands. Pass the horse to each child as you say, "Howdy, (child's name)!"

SAY

Good job obeying, buckaroos! When we read the Bible, we learn that God tells us to obey Him and others. Everyone say this after me: (Pause to allow kids to repeat after you)

God (both hands point up)
Tells Me (thumbs to chest)
To Obey (salute)

READ THE BIBLE

DO

Sanitize kids' hands, and give them each a **Coloring Sheet**. Then place the **crayons** in the center of the group. Allow kids to color while you read the **Bible Story Cards** to the group.

MEMORIZE IT

SAY & DO

There's a verse in the Bible that tells us God loves us and has a good plan for you and me. Let's practice it together! Just repeat after me: (Pause to allow kids to say each line)

"God is (both hands point up)
always at work (pound fists on top of each other)
for the good of everyone (two thumbs up)
who loves Him." (hug self)
Romans 8:28 (make book with hands)

Hey God! Please help us to obey You and others. Thank You for loving us so much! We love You! In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
