

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

This week, our TapKids will learn the importance of worship with God's family and loving others like Christ in this time of fear. Our Scripture passage this week comes from **Acts 2: 42-47**.

We are encouraging the children to spend time with Jesus through prayer and His Word in order that we may love on others.

As a family throughout the week:

- Take time this week to pray for doctors, nurses, and health care workers who are working hard to take care of the sick. Pray for the elderly such as grandparents that God would protect them from sickness. Pray for sick friends that God would heal them and be near to them, and that God would provide for those who are struggling for food and shelter.
- Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 and write down three words that describe love and what it looks like in the current context.
- Read 1 Thessalonians 5:12-18
- Find The Rizers 1 Thessalonians 5:15-18 on YouTube and use it to memorize the verses as well as to worship together as a family.
