Hope you all had a wonderful week! How much longer is it until school is over? This week, our TapKids learn about what it means to tame our tongues and why we should do so and how to do so.

Family Devotional for the week:

Monday: Dear Lord, I'd like to pray for all the people that I love, but who live far away. Tonight with them my thoughts I share. Please keep them in Your loving care, each night and every day.

Tuesday: Read James 3:1-12 together as a family. Parents, share how God has spoken to you through this passage. What does it look like to tame your tongue?

Wednesday: Listen to Build My Life and spend time worshipping together as a family. After singing, spend time as a family about how you can build your life around God and what adjustments you might need to take in order to do so.

Thursday: Reflect together what are the biggest influencers in your family. Then share what you notice in your children that influences your children and have the children point out what they think influences you. Confess, repent, and return to Jesus to be your #1 influencer.

Friday: Read and meditate on Psalm 23:1-5 and memorize up to verse 5 as a family. Recite it together throughout the weekend..
