With the new covid-19 restrictions announcements on Sept 16th, we are mandating and implementing the following safety protocols for all of our gatherings until such restrictions are lifted

Stay in your seated area during the service

Within reason, once you have entered the sanctuary and found your spot please refrain from unnecessarily moving about



Wash your hands

Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water or using alcohol or hand sanitizer.



Take precaution when sneezing or coughing

Cover your nose and mouth with your bent elbow or a tissue when you cough or sneeze.



If you are feeling sick, please stay home

If you're sick or suspect yourself to be sick, it's best to stay home. You can still join us on the livestream by going to redroof.tv



Wear a mask at all times

Mandatory masking has been reinstated in all indoor spaces in Saskatchewan. Please be diligent to keep your mask on and be respectful of those around you in the process



Practice social distancing

Be mindful of the people around you, doing your best to maintain at least 2 meters (6 feet) distance from others. Sanctuary seating will return to being in pods
