

Guidelines to attend CFC in-person services

You and all household members (people you are presently living with) must answer NO to all 3 questions in the questionnaire each week to attend in person church activities (CDC guidelines as of 7/20/2020) and also follow the guidelines for ending home isolation if you have come in contact with a person that has tested positive for Covid-19.

- A. Have you or any household member been exposed to a known COVID-19 positive person in the last 2 weeks?
- B. Have you or any household member had a fever (100.5 deg F or higher) or taken medication for fever in the last 3 days?
- C. Do you or any household member currently have unexplained respiratory or possible COVID-19 symptoms (shortness of breath, cough, new loss of taste or smell, headache, congestion or runny nose, diarrhea, vomiting, fatigue/body aches, etc.) that was not present 4 weeks ago?

Guidelines to end home isolation after coming in contact with a person who has tested positive for Covid-19.

NOTE: If you or a household member has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past, follow the CDC guidelines about ending home isolation after testing positive. There are different guidelines based on different conditions.

For those with mild to moderate illness:

- 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND
- at least 24hrs have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, AND
- symptoms have improved

If you were asymptomatic and not severely immunocompromised:

- may end home isolation 10 days after you tested positive for COVID-19

For those with severe to critical illness:

- 20 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND
- at least 24hrs have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, AND
- symptoms have improved

If you were asymptomatic and severely immunocompromised:

- may end home isolation 20 days after you tested positive for COVID-19

The questionnaire is to be used each time you are about to attend an in person church event. The questionnaire will be made available when an attendee registers for an in person service.
