
Grades 2 to 6 | July 19-22

# Volunteer @ East Ave Church

#### Facilities Team

We buy food by the pound from the Butte County Food Bank in Oroville, receive food from Gleaners in Chico and whatever we still need we get from Winco.

A cash donation is the most economical way to get food to hungry people (Text-to-Give with the keyword "food"). As always, you can designate any gift with an envelope and a box on the back wall.

Anabel received the Butte Creek Foundation Scholarship and will be attending the Royal Veternary College in London.




Denim Brillenz Durham High School

Cole will be attending California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo with an architecture major and construction management minor.


