In light of the early morning invasion on February 24, all of our remaining SEND workers have temporarily relocated to locations outside of Ukraine. Big Idea: SECRECY IS THE ENEMY OF INTIMACY

### GETTING STARTED

Share a story of being caught as a kid for doing something to get into trouble. What was your response? What were the consequences?

### REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- After Adam and Eve ate the apple in Genesis 3, they hid from God in the garden.
   Why?
- 2. How do you normally respond when you feel the conviction of God's Spirit? Do you hide from God and ignore it, or do you seek His forgiveness right away?
- 3. Reflect on Psalm 119:9-11 below. What is the key to staying pure? How does this affect who you hang out with, what you watch, and where you go?
- 4. "I promise to confide in you and not hide from you." Give some practical examples of what this means in relationships (marriage, parent/child, adult/older parents, etc.) How does this principle relate to trust in a relationship?
- 5. There are all kinds of temptations that seek to divide marriages and other close relationships. What can you do to eliminate temptation before it happens? What boundaries can you put around your marriage or your life to stay pure?
- 6. What is something that will stick with you from this series: THE VOW? Why? What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

**PRAYER:** Lord, we offer our lives to you. Keep us walking in the light, not in darkness. Thank you for spiritual friends who walk with us and hold us accountable. In the name of Jesus, Amen.

**GOING DEEPER:** Read Genesis 3:1-24. Why does God go look for Adam and Eve? How does He offer grace to them, even in the midst of their sin? Where does God provide grace for you?

## **FOCUS SCRIPTURES:**
