

Redeemer Food Pantry is here to help!

We understand that unexpected situations happen and extra help is sometimes needed. All names are kept confidential and you will find our volunteers to be very friendly and welcoming.

The food pantry is located inside Redeemer Church and open every Tuesday from 10:00 am -2:00 pm or 5:30 pm -7:00 pm. We do curbside service at door number 5. Each family that visits receives a week's worth of food & personal care items based on their family size. We not only have food available, but we also have personal care items such as: shampoo, soap, toilet paper, and feminine products.

Under our grant guidelines, you must live in Clinton County and are allowed to visit once a month (approximately every 30 days). If you do not live in Clinton County, please contact 517-908-3680 to find the one closest pantry to you.

We do ask that you have a referral to visit, but if you cannot get one for the first visit, we will serve you and ask that you get one for the second month and going forward. You only need to renew your referral every 12 months.

Referrals can be obtained from Michigan Dept of Health & Human Services (1-844-464-3447). Or, if you do not work with DHS, you may qualify for a referral through Christian Services (517-394-5411), Caring & Sharing Family Life Services, Wraparound, Eight-Cap, Headstart, WIC, St. Vincent de Paul, CACS, Housing Services of Mid-Michigan MSU Extension or the Health Department.
