Getting Started

In high school, who were two of your best friends? What was one quality about them that stands out to you?

Reflection/Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think God gave Adam and Eve work to do in the Garden of Eden?
- 2. Paul reminds the early Christians to "work willingly at whatever you do, as working for the Lord." When is this easy or challenging?
- 3. What do you find most fulfilling about the work that you do now?
- 4. Where could you use a little bit of "spark" in your everyday life? What feels monotonous or routine in your life right now? Why?
- 5. "My work doesn't define my worth." What is the bigger purpose behind what you do?

- 6. "My work is my ministry." How can you be an agent for Christ in what you do every day?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

Prayer: Lord God, thank you for the work that you called Adam and Eve to do so long ago and the work you still call us to do today. Help us to remember that you are our ultimate "boss" and the work that we do matters. Help us to find our worth in You and not to depend only on outward success. We are so grateful for all that you do through us. In the name of Christ, we pray. Amen.

Going Deeper: Read Colossians 3:1-17. The section is entitled "Rules for Holy Living." How does "setting your mind on things above" (v.2) relate to the behaviors described in vs.12-17? How can we do everything in the name in the Lord Jesus? (v.17)
