We are excited to be able to worship together each Sunday at 9:30 and 11:00 am and livestreaming on YouTube starting at 9:30 am!

The State of New Hampshire has guidelines and recommendations for churches. These guidelines bring some temporary changes to our services but allow us to resume in-person corporate worship in a manner that respects the realities of COVID-19 and follows the public health guidelines.

We will keep the building at limited capacity to leave plenty of space for social distancing. Because of the limited capacity, [we are asking everyone to RSVP online](#). RSVPing is not required by any outside agency. It merely helps us plan for the number of seats available for each service.

Despite some limitations, we are thrilled that many of us will be able to gather in person very soon. We long for the day when this public health crisis is past, and we can gather together again without any such restrictions. Whether you can join us in person or at home via live-stream, we pray that the Holy Spirit will strengthen and encourage us to be the church He has called Wellspring to be.

**PLEASE WATCH THE ONLINE SERVICE FROM HOME IF:**

You or anyone in your household is exhibiting any of the following symptoms:

- fever, cough,
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, sore throat
- new loss of taste or smell.
- if you have tested positive for COVID-19, even without symptoms, or if you are known to have come in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 until you have completed the required 14-day quarantine period.

**RSVPing:** As explained above, we ask everyone to RSVP for each service you plan to attend.

**ENTRY:** Please enter the building at the main entrance.

**CHILDREN:** We are not able to offer any nursery or children's ministry at this time. Children must remain with their parents at all times.

**COFFEE HOUR:** We are not able to offer a coffee hour at this time and so we will resume coffee hour at a later date.

**PHYSICAL CONTACT:** We are asking that everyone restrain from hugs and handshakes at this time.

**AIR EXCHANGE:** When the weather allows, windows and doors will be left open to maximize air exchange.

**FACIAL COVERINGS:** Facial coverings are not required by the State of New Hampshire, but they will be available upon arrival if you do not bring your own. We are asking people to wear masks in the building whenever proper social distancing cannot be achieved (such as in the lobby or bathrooms).

We know that there are strong feelings on both sides of the facial covering issue. We are trying to create an environment where we can maximize comfort level for all. Please respect one another in the matter of facial coverings.
