This Report is in honor of the life and ministry of Evangelist Dr. Joram Dol of India who went home to be with the Lord on April 11, 2022 following the mission.

MISSION OVERVIEW

This strategic 5-Fold Global mission was very unique and challenging. It required months of logistical and spiritual preparation. It involved a 7-nation team at the beginning (Dr. Samuel Isong of Nigeria, Dr. Joram Dol of India, Apostle Sampson Dorkunor of Ghana, Bishop Wilberforce Musoni of Rwanda, Dr. Michael Gross of USA, Pastor Edward Lokose of South Sudan, Apostle Alex Niwagaba of Uganda, and Bishop Charles Owino of Uganda) The primary target of the mission was the Palorinya Refugee Settlement Camp where thousands of displaced people from South Sudan were located inside the border of Uganda (see map on the

right). 5-Fold Global had conducted а strategic operation in South Sudan nine years earlier. networking relationship had been established by the Holy Spirit during that time with several key leaders of the New Nation Church International, One of those leaders was Pastor Edward Lokose Elisama. We began to work together in planning the operation with nine church groups for a 12-day program to include daily equipping sessions for 500 disciples and evenina



crusades reaching the six districts or zones spread out in the camp. One of the first things the Holy Spirit directed was to begin the Fishers of Men Rapid Deployment Training Center (RDTC) with 12 carefully selected young disciples. We immediately implemented the Ephesus strategy in Acts 19 ensuring first of all that each of the 12 were baptized with the Holy Spirit like the 12 disciples Paul encountered in Ephesus. We then placed a mobile phone in each of their hands with the capacity to download, view, and take notes of all 5-Fold Global resources step by step in a two-year equipping program like at the School of Tyrannus in Ephesus. This early training of the 12 provided a strong foundation of ministry for the mission. 5-Fold Global Equipping Teams depend heavily on the leaders residing in the field of operation. The resident team was fully prepared beyond our expectations.

The timing of the mission was also directed by the Spirit. One of the key verses was *For a great and effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries* (1Cor. 16:9). Another key verse was *But I know that when I come to you, I shall come in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ* (Rom. 15:29). These verses and others thrust the 5-Fold Team forward under the supervision of the Holy Spirit. Although we always face demonic resistance on every operation, this one was most intense. First, there was the battle with confusing and rapidly changing Covid 19 testing requirements to get the 5-Fold Global Team to Uganda. It seemed every government and airport were different. Brother Sampson was prevented from coming due to severe Covid mandates in Ghana. The costs of testing also kept rising but we made it in and when we arrived at Entebbe Airport we passed through without the required retest. Michael arrived first from the USA on March 4 to rest up and coordinate some final logistics with Brother Alex Niwagaba of True Love Victory Church International who was planning our travel to the Refugee Camp. Wilberforce Musoni of Rwanda arrived on March 5 to

visit family in Kampala and to pick up Samuel Isong of Nigeria and Joram Dol of India on March 8 to join Michael at the 24/7 Hotel in Mukono. The team was full of joy to be together. Our love for one another in Christ is very deep as we have worked together for many years.

The next battle was with the Prime Minister's office and the Commission for Refugees. The Refugee Camp had told us earlier that the camp director had given approval. Thankfully, Brother Alex had followed up on this with Pastor Edward and discovered a permit was required from the Prime Minister's office. He submitted the request in a timely manner but when he and Michael went to the government office, they got the typical bureaucratic run around. We ended up at the Commission for Refugees and was able with the help of a young woman named Praise and a security guard name Christmas to make the necessary changes to the letter of request. The LORD has those in every place to assist His servants. Alex made the first attempt and returned with the requirement that a copy of each of our passports was needed. Praise God Michael had them on his mobile phone and Sister Praise immediately printed them out. The security guard, Christmas, personally escorted Alex into the Commission of Refugees office for the 2nd attempt with the advice to have a small envelope of 50,000 Uganda Schillings. The secretary saw the envelope and quickly placed it in her pocket and then took the request with the passport copies into the commissioner's office. Now it was a waiting game as we prayed




for God to give us favor. In the meantime, Michael and Alex decided to repair his 7-passenger van (pictured with Joram on left) instead of hiring a driver and vehicle for the long journey into northern Uganda. This proved to be the wisdom of God despite a number of breakdowns for repairs along the way. We delayed our travel to the camp for one day until we heard from the Commission for Refugees. Associate Pastor Aaron of True Love Victory Church International was onsite representing us when more information was requested. This time they wanted to know what kind of humanitarian and financial aid was being provided. Michael guickly forwarded the food list and detailed budget. They indicated all money was to go through them but praise God all finances had already been sent directly to Pastor Edward. We share this with you so you can get a picture of God's foreknowledge and working all things out for His plan and purposes on such a strategic mission. The permit came through but only allowing for 3 days from March 11 to 14. Pastor Edward's response to this

development echoed the team's reaction "I am full of the Holy Ghost joy. We refuse to be discouraged because we know God knows all this. The Bible says, 'Many are the plans of man but nevertheless the purpose of God prevails." The team departed for the camp at 5AM on March 10 only to breakdown at a gas station near Gulu about halfway on the journey. It took several hours for vehicle repairs before we were on our way to catch the West Nile River Ferry. We missed the last ferry, so the team had to spend the night in the vehicle at the remote river crossing eating some dried fish and cold potatoes. The next morning, we crossed the river and made it to the camp to begin ministry with the 500 disciples and conduct the first crusade. We learned upon our arrival that a rainstorm with high winds had struck the camp the night before destroying many of their dwelling places.

The above overview displays the wisdom and endurance that the LORD had given to this 5-Fold Global Team. So many unexpected interruptions, delays, limitations, and sufferings in a remote climate of intense heat and yet the team possessed a supernatural strength and a joyful attitude in being together and serving the LORD on this mission. We all had the

understanding that the LORD was orchestrating and in control of every unexpected event. The devil could not boast or receive any credit. Brother Wilberforce Musoni of Rwanda made these reflections during the mission: "Most of us are no aliens to delays, detours, and distractions through the past couple of years. I want to remind you that God is always at work amidst these interruptions. You may have found yourself in places you would not normally go or with people you would not normally encounter, but that very well may be the precise direction that God is purposely leading you. I believe the number of divine interruptions we experience in our lifetime often directly correlates with our willingness to be interrupted. If you are willing to make space for divine interruptions, you may be surprised with what God will do! I can certainly testify to the TRUTH that God's divine direction and promptings yield profit, peace, and all the awesome blessings that come with it (see Psalms 32:8). 5-Fold Global operations bring those expectations live." Samuel Isong also reflected on this team dynamic: "Remember we were all joyful... There was no grief in any heart regarding our experiences in the mission field. There was no pain in any heart in the team. We enjoyed everything. We enjoyed every suffering. It was even difficult to notice if we were suffering. The joy of a bountiful harvest never allowed us to consider any negative." It was evident to all that this team had been sent by the Holy Spirit into this specific mission field at this specific time.



STRATEGIC MISSION HIGHLIGHTS

March 6-7 (Sunday, Monday) Michael ministers at True Love Victory Church International. He

preached at both the morning and evening services on a variety of topics. He shared about the mission, suffering with Christ, self-denial for the sake of Christ, being ready for persecution, being filled with the Holy Spirit, the true teaching of the Word verses false teaching, and true repentance. The next day Alex, Aaron, and Michael spent morning to evening following up on the government permit and vehicle repairs in Kampala.



March 8-10 (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday) The rest of the team arrived at Mukono in the evening. Everyone had originally been scheduled to arrive in the morning at Entebbe Airport but schedule changes by airlines had altered our best made plans. We all rested and prayed the next day as we waited for news about the permit and made last minute vehicle repairs. We began our journey to the Palorinya Refugee Settlement Camp very early in the morning of March 10 once the 3-day permit came through. Little did we know that we would face another vehicle repair for a timing belt and have to spend the night at the remote West Nile Ferry crossing.

March 11-14 (Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday) Ministry at the Palorinya Refugee Settlement Camp. Brother Alex posted this update on the 5-Fold Global Team: "Thanks all for your prayers and encouragement. We crossed the river Nile with a ferry today at 7:30am and reached the camp (the place of ministry) at 9:50am. We had a successful morning session (conference) and this evening we are having an open-air Gospel Crusade.". Five hundred carefully selected



disciples (pictured left) from nine church groups gathered daily under a large mango tree. Each morning Michael briefly laid the foundation for the equipping ministry. He began by introducing the team. He explained that the 5-Fold Global Team was to be considered as nothing more than servants of the LORD sent to them by the Holy Spirit. He instructed everyone not to address the team with titles during the

conference because we are all one in Christ and His servants. He presented a session on the *Doctrine of Christ*. The presentation was designed to expand the equipping of the twelve in the Fishers of Men RDTC to the 500 disciples. Each day powerful teaching sessions released the power of God's word and the Holy Spirit upon those gathered. One of those teachings was by Samuel on *God's Prophetic Seasons and Doctrinal Foundation for the Church*. He used the seven feasts of the Jews to illustrate how each established the spiritual doctrines for the church. For example, the Passover signifies the power of deliverance through the shed blood of Jesus. *Without the blood there is no salvation. Nothing is meant to replace the blood. The blood is the mark of salvation. The unleavened bread signifies the burial of Christ. We are buried in the ground with Jesus. Sin's power is broken. The dominion of sin is no more. There is pride in the church. There is rising sin in the church. Make sure you stand on the right teachings of Christ. Practice the laid down doctrines of Christ. Don't change the word of God. God has set the pattern, not man and not culture. The feast of Firstfruits has to do with the resurrection of Christ. Jesus is the first. Don't be afraid of death when you are serving God. It is for preparation. At the*

right time and season power will be turned over to you. Don't pretend what you are not. When you lower yourself you will be lifted. When you lift yourself you will be humbled. Jesus is your firstfruits. Pentecost speaks of the coming of the Holy Spirit and the great harvest season. This is our time. No other feast has been fulfilled. The church was invested with power on the day of Pentecost. The feast of trumpets signifies the rapture and the second coming of Christ. The rapture is no longer emphasized in the church. It has been replaced with teachings on prosperity. The expectation of believers has been reduced to a big house and a bigger car. Remember, they will become what they hear you say. Christ is coming back! The feast of atonement signifies a future time when Christ appears, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem will mourn and see the One they have pierced. Finally, the feast of trumpets announces that God's kingdom has come. The church is to respect the coming of Jesus. The church demonstrates the power of His kingdom. Another presentation by Brother Wilberforce of Rwanda was on the topic of prophecy from Hosea 6:1-3: Come, and let us return to the LORD; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. ² After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, that we may live in His sight. 3 Let us know, pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth. This was a very timely message revealing God's purpose for being in the Refugee Camp. The Bible says come back to God. He will heal us. If you get to know why you are here, then He will carry you. The reason we are in the camp is because the inner man had to be revived. Hosea says we have to return to the LORD. After two days He will revive us. Church, we are in those 2 days. A day is like a thousand years and a thousand years is like a day to the LORD. We are in the end times. Jesus is coming but before He comes, He has to revive us. God brought you here. When you love your enemies, God will revive you. God is going to take you back to your nation. Realize the opportunity to be close to God. He is ready to heal us, and He will carry us. Today, has been a prophetic message. He can do greater things. Over 50 backsliding disciples came forth to be revived and five unsaved received salvation following these sessions. The team also noticed some demonic activity that distracted attention from what the Holy Spirit was doing with the 500 disciples. We instructed those needing deliverance to be immediately removed to a nearby room where leaders along with the twelve cast the demons out while the team continued ministry with the 500. We followed this practice during all the remaining equipping sessions.

The first evening crusade was like no other a 5-Fold Global Team had experienced. A mass of people gathered at a marketplace. There was a reasonable time of singing and dancing

for we had given careful instructions to focus on the unsaved while keeping in mind a 7:00pm curfew imposed on the Settlement Camp. It was now time for our Evangelist, Joram, to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Brother Joram is small in physical stature but mighty in the LORD. There was no place for him to preach from except an anthill (pictured right). Nothing stops Joram from preaching the Gospel! He steps right up on the anthill and preaches the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ. Many gave their lives to Christ and Brother Alex assisted with testimonies of those who had been healed from a variety of physical infirmities including a deaf woman who could now hear. The LORD was glorified, and the team affectionately referred to Joram as the *Anthill Evangelist*. Joram continued to preach each crusade in accordance with his calling and giftedness from God. Each



remaining crusade he became very aggressive by the Spirit against the witchcraft and demonic darkness oppressing the people. Demons would scream out and become violent as he ministered God's word. The team including the twelve being equipped at the Fishers of Men RDTC would rush in to minister deliverance. In one case a young woman violently thrashed about with such force that she could barely be restrained by five men. As we were all taking authority over the demons in this woman and others the Spirit spoke to Michael saying, *he is legion*. This was quickly shared with Samuel, and we all cast *legion* out of the woman in the name of Jesus. She was completely set free! Samuel led her into deep repentance and salvation in Christ. He also learned that thousands of demons visited her every night. This woman then got her Muslim friend and in the presence of Samuel led her friend in repentance and the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. What made this such a remarkable event is that these two women were from an unreached group within the camp and now would be used by God to evangelize their community of refugees for the glory of Christ. There was also a display of the Holy Spirit's power in the presence of all as a large group of young people suddenly fell to the ground under the power of God. Many rushed in amazement to see what had happened.

The 3-day ministry at the Refugee Camp did not end with the 5-Fold Global Team. Pastor Edward, the twelve, and key leaders among the nine church groups completed the 12 days as scheduled with daily equipping sessions for the 500 disciples and evening crusades. Their report will be included in the concluding remarks.

March 14-17 (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday) The team departed the Refugee



Settlement Camp on Monday morning and arrived at the Metu Moyo region for a 3-day conference hosted by Pastor Peter Anyama of Embassy of Light Church (pictured left with Michael). Although our emergency provision was all but gone and we faced another vehicle repair, we knew this unexpected assignment was a Macedonia call for help that could not be ignored. The believers in Metu welcomed us with open arms and freely provided lodging and food for the team throughout our stay. We rested and also celebrated Joram's 47th birthday in the evening of March 14. Our love for one another and joy in serving the LORD

together cannot be expressed in words. The team conducted several daily equipping sessions with crusades each evening. Joram followed a challenging message from Michael on the dangers of the tradition of men from Mark 7:5-13. He presented a very important and comprehensive teaching on What is the Church. The root of our faith is Jesus Christ. To know the church is very important. The church as a building is not the biblical understanding of church. The church is not a building but people, the believers. The Bible says, Greet the church that is in their house (Rom. 16:5). The church is the body of Christ, and He is the Head (Eph. 1:21-23). The denominational churches are not the local church but people in one place who gather. The Bible says you are the church. There is only one foundation, Jesus Christ (1Cor. 3:11). How are you building your spiritual foundation? How have you laid your foundation? What was the process? This is very important my brothers and sisters. One day all will be tested by the fire (1Cor. 3:12-13). God is asking today how you lay your foundation in the church? One day your spiritual foundation will be tested by the fire. God is interested in dwelling in us. Be an overcoming Christian. We are the temple of God. Joram concluded the message with some important revelations about the 5-Fold Ministry in the church (Eph. 2:20; 4:11-13). God gave them to equip the church and to build the church. The church is under your custody. A leader is one who makes new leaders. Don't try to be a one-man soldier. God is interested in rebuilding the fallen tent (Acts 15:16). The Bible is saying your tent has fallen. Why do denominational

churches collapse? Why are they fallen down? The tent made with human hands has collapsed. How far apart from God we have come but God is rebuilding what has fallen down.

The 5-Fold Global Team presented more anointed teachings like the one above throughout the 3-day conference. Samuel taught on *Leadership* and *Standing Fast in Obedience* to all that you have heard from God. Wilberforce presented a session on *The Second Coming of Christ* and Michael taught on *Launching out into the Deep*. These messages were collectively used by God to revive and transform the region. The evening crusades provided some challenges. Motor bikes took us to the crusade locations until the vehicle was repaired. Joram and Alex worked effectively together to gather in a harvest. Peter and his team rejoiced over every healing and salvation. They were so grateful to God for sending us to them that they announced they would slaughter and roast a goat for our final meal together.

March 18-21 (Friday, Saturday, Sunday) We departed Metu, caught the infamous West Nile

Ferry (pictured right), and proceeded on the long journey back to Mukono arriving at Pastor Aaron and Olivia's home late in the evening. Alex had arranged for us to lodge in their home until the Kiyindi Conference. The team needed rest after the long journey, and we had to pray through some of the challenges facing us in completing the remainder of the mission. It had been determined that Michael and Joram would depart a few days earlier than planned so Michael could extend the provision necessary to get everyone retested for Covid and back to their nations. Uganda had more than doubled the costs of these tests and the team



had exhausted its emergency provision. On Sunday, Alex sent team members to different churches. Michael and Joram ministered at True Love Victory Church International. Samuel preached at Kingdom Revival Christian Church International and Wilberforce at Goldfield Church. There were good reports from each assignment. In addition, the churches presented offerings to the servants of God. The total came to 105,100 UGX (\$29.82) which was needed for gas. Joram preached on revival from John 7:37-39 during the evening service where around 65 gathered at True Love Victory Church International. We are waiting for the great day of revival. The church today needs the power of the Holy Spirit. No Holy Spirit, no revival! The Holy Spirit moved upon those gathered. Healing testimonies revealed pain and sickness departing men and women in the name of Jesus. A woman whose right ear was ringing since birth went away completely healed. A young man with Covid was healed of chest pain and coughing. Also, a young girl that was very sick was healed and the sickness was immediately gone for the glory of Christ.



March 22-25 (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday) The team departed for the Kiyindi Conference (pictured left) on the shores of Lake Victoria hosted by Bishop Charles Owino. We stayed in the compound of Pastor John where we had stayed before on a previous mission. The main room was filled with people at the evening house fellowship. Michael shared from 1:1-3 Revelation and exhorted everyone that the time is near. Suddenly, there was an outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and many were filled and began speaking in tongues. Two women were delivered from demons including one with the spirit of death. We began the conference the next day. This conference focused on revival. Charles had shared: Your visit is timely. God has directed your way as lukewarmness has taken over due to the lockdowns which included churches. I believe that God is bringing you purposely to ignite the fire of the Holy Ghost and cause a great revival in Uganda and Africa at large. The people were in desperate need of being revived. Michael and Joram were assigned to the first day of the conference since they would begin their journey home on the next day. Michael taught on A Measure of Revival. Joram followed with a Mission Challenge on how we are all called to do the work of an evangelist and that the great commission is for all of us. Michael ended the first day of the conference with a message entitled, The Church on Fire where he presented a detailed analysis of the major emphases of the Early Church from the book of Acts. These teachings provided an excellent foundation for the remaining days of the conference. This was later confirmed by Samuel and Charles who stated: Now on Fire on the 2nd day. Bishop Charles confirmed the people were dull and down in Spirit on the 1st day but on fire the 2nd because they were hungry from the 1st day. The messages and ministrations on the first day began igniting the fire in them. Yesterday, March 24th was amazing. Your desire was granted, fire fell. Teachings were awesome. You can see the burning fire so real. Teaching came in utmost surprising wisdom. Men were convicted as they listened to my teaching on The Seven Principles of Extra Oil for Meeting the Bridegroom at Last. It came in a deep and practical awakening flow. The evening session was over 60 new generation moved in ministry. They wept bitterly for wasting their years not serving the Lord practically. I spoke on The Hidden Power of Leaders in the New Generation. It was awesome. The fire is more than I can explain. Joy everywhere. Testimonies on every lip.



March 26-28 (Saturday, Sunday, Monday) Samuel, Wilberforce, and Alex (pictured left) conducted the 3-day conference at True Love Victory Church International. Samuel sent this report: We arrived Mukono early as at about 9:30am today. We started the conference around 1:30. I took first session on Components of the Great Commission. It was a good foundation laying. We saw the people very broken, yielded in tears to obey the Lord hence forth, the teaching came with deep insight on Christ authority over the entire universe. Leaders from other churches are attending the session. Is good gathering. Word reception is high. It was a good gathering today. The first session was by Wilberforce. He spoke from Hosea 6:1-2. I spoke on the remaining six components of the Great Commission. It was by fire.

Afternoon session was also very okay. A very good attendance. The people are very hungry and receptive. Today afternoon session had people from outside True Love in attendance. Wilberforce preach on 2nd death. I took the last session on the principles of extra oil to burn till the Master returns. The presence of the Lord was evident all through. To God be all be all the glory. We finished strong this evening. God answered your prayers. Real fire came down, weeping, repentance, baptism of the Holy Spirit, and healings were so real. We finished strong and with much joy. Hallelujah! Brother Alex concluded: God has used Dr. Samuel and Bishop Wilberforce to teach and equip the Church in Kiwanga Mukono, Uganda. People have learned, gotten encouraged in the LORD, and have received the Holy Spirit. They have been set on fire for Jesus and are ready for the persecution in Jesus mighty name. The conference also provided an offering of 196,4000 UGX (\$55.68) to 5-Fold Global which was applied to expenses for the remaining team in Uganda.

LESSONS LEARNED

- God can use anything, and He can work good out of all things. This includes difficulties, unexpected challenges, setbacks, delays. Although the enemy tries to use them to hinder us, God knows about them all beforehand and will use them to direct us in His paths and fulfill His purpose. (Rom. 5:3-5; 8:28)
- How leaders and believers understand and fellowship with the sufferings of Christ must align with God's word. Our spiritual understanding and our attitude with suffering as servants of the LORD are shaped by the Word of God and the examples of the Early Church. (Phil. 3:10-11; Acts 5:41-42; 2Cor. 4:7-18).
- The implementation of sound biblical strategies for evangelism and discipleship with equipping by Ephesian 4:11 leaders produce unity and maturity in believers and fruit that remains for the glory of Christ. (Eph. 4:11-16).
- The importance of the foundation laying and exhortation ministry of apostles and prophets must be recognized by the church today if it is to be ready for what is coming and able to stand in obedience in the last days. (Eph. 2: 19-22).
- Mission effectiveness increases and decreases in the field of operation in relation to the degree to which leaders are focused upon and attentive to the mission on hand.
- The church needs to use social media to the fullest extent to preach and make disciples, however, digital ministry is not to replace the sending by the Holy Spirit of God's servants to the nations. (Acts 13:1–5).
- Strategic mission operations directed by the Holy Spirit will become increasingly more
 difficult and dangerous for those sent by the Spirit into the harvest fields. It is a call for the
 servants of the LORD to be strong, courageous, and to overcome. (Rev. 12:11).
- The receiving and distribution of God's provision for a strategic operation must be accomplished with the utmost care and integrity. (2Kings 22:7; Acts 6:1-7).
- God is sovereign in all things. He rules and is victorious in life and in death. The servants of the LORD are also victorious and more than conquerors in both life and death through Jesus Christ. (1Cor. 15:56; Rom. 8:31-39).

CONCLUDING REMARKS

The effectiveness of any strategic mission centers around what takes place after the 5-Fold Global Team has departed. We experienced one of the most prepared and engaged ground teams at the Palorinya Refugee Settlement Camp. Pastor Edward, the 12 in the Fishers of Men RDTC, and the leaders from nine church groups ministered side by side with the 5-Fold Global Team. They also carefully recorded all the names and locations of each new convert for follow-up so the harvest net would not be broken. The photo below is more than a photo. It displays a spiritual impartation of increased anointing upon three generations chosen by God ready to expand and flow upon 500 hungry and thirsty disciples waiting in the background.



Our beloved Brother Edward has adopted the Ephesus strategy of discipleship outlined in Acts 19. 5-Fold Global is assisting him in this strategic development. We also rejoice that Brother Peter Anyama of Embassy of Light Church will also implement this strategy for the Metu Moyo region.

Pastor Edward presents the following report on the mission at the Refugee Settlement Camp: Praise God my Beloved Brother in Christ. It's with great pleasure to inform you that we concluded the 12-day training sessions and crusades safely as God's hand was manifested and many souls were won for Christ and were baptized. Demons were cast out in the name of Jesus Christ, deliverance and restoration was ministered, and general counseling was done as per the report below: From the 11 to 21 March 2022.

- 1- Repentance (souls won for Christ) = 534
- 2- People healed from various diseases = 191
- 3- Water Baptisms = 29
- 4- Casting out demons = 22
- 5- Restoration = 64
- 6- Deliverance = 112
- 7- General counseling = 23

The mission was successful though our expectations for the harvest was a bit higher than what we achieved. This was due to reasons beyond our control as we missed 2



days of crusades due to heavy rains. Again, the mission was scheduled earlier before the reopening of schools due to the world pandemic and most pupils were already at schools when the mission kicked off and we couldn't do anything. However, this mission has started a great revival and transformation in the communities reached. It's our prayer that the vision will continue as its impact is already great in the settlement. We see souls won for Christ and many people healed from various kinds of diseases. We shall continue to reach out to the communities with crusades as we trust God to lead us wherever possible. We pray for the WILL of God to be done in whatsoever His plan may be.



Bishop Charles Owino (pictured left with Samuel) also sent the following report following the Kiyindi Conference: Receive warm greetings from Kivindi, Grace Evangelical Church. Thank you so much for such precious opportunity granted to us to be one of the places to be visited. Your visit made a great impact especially the youths. Eight youths who shared their testimony said, they were baptized by fire and received the Holy Spirit. .Among them, a lady spoke in new tongues. Adults also received the power of the Holy Ghost. Three adults who shared with us said they worshipped God in truth and Spirit for the first time. Your message and that one of

Dr. Joram, did not leave us the same. Well, I sensed that for the first session the message was not getting a breakthrough in the lives of the people. But later on in the second session there was a breakthrough. From that time up to the end of our conference, there was total breakthrough. The first day we had 190 participants [congregation]. The second day 240, the last day 280 people. Whoever went back home, would invite a friend. We thank God so much for your financial help. As the number kept on increasing, we also had a financial challenge. However, we did not look at it as a challenge. But we thanked God for the impact the conference made in our church and the neighborhoods. Remember us in your prayers as we also pray for you. Not forgetting the home fellowship where two people were delivered from demonic powers. We thank you so much and request that another time as you plan to visit East Africa please, Kiyindi should always be inclusive. Even though we remained with some debts to pay, we need your prayers for a breakthrough and all the honor and glory will go to our Lord.

5-Fold Global met the increased financial challenge so the church would not be burdened and what the LORD had accomplished in Kiyindi would not be diminished in any way.

The success of this mission came at a very high cost. Brother Michael and Joram became very sick with severe malaria and other things a few days following their return home. Michael was hospitalized from April 1-7 and Joram was in a critical care unit (CCU) in India. Much prayer went forth around the world. Our beloved Evangelist, Dr. Joram Dol, departed for glory on April 11, 2022. This broke all our hearts with such a deep sorrow that only the comfort of God could reach. Although this would be his final mission to the nations on earth, the fruit of his ministry during this strategic operation remains and will be remembered forever. He will be an example to all of us to be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord (1Cor. 15:58). He displayed with other 5-Fold Global Team members on this mission the same perspective that the Apostle Paul had in going to Jerusalem. And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, ²³ except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. ²⁴ But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God (Acts 20:22-24).
