

Bible Story Summary

- Tax collectors and sinners came to listen to Jesus teach.
- The religious leaders complained because Jesus welcomed sinners, so Jesus told them three stories to teach them about God.
- The first story was about a man who had 100 sheep. He lost one of his sheep and left the other 99 to find it. The man celebrated when he found the lost sheep.

Activity
