

BCLR COVID-19 Congregating and Building Use Procedures

Updated September 9, 2020

Building Access

- All main entrances are available. However, access to the western hallway running through the BCLR Kids nursery area is only available through the foyer when the nursery is in use. Anyone entering the western door when the nursery is in use will be directed upstairs or to another entrance.
- The front (southern) entrance will be propped open for touchless entry and exit on Sunday mornings.

Face Coverings

- Children 2 and under are strongly discouraged from wearing face coverings.
- Children 3-10 years old may wear face coverings at the discretion of their guardians.
- Everyone older than 10 years old is strongly encouraged to wear face coverings while indoors. Face coverings will be made available to anyone who does not have one.

Physical Distancing

- Physical distancing of 6 feet from others with whom there is not regular exposure outside of BCLR is strongly encouraged.
- Worship Center seating is available in marked pews in order to facilitate physical distancing.
- Sunday morning corporate worship services are live-streamed in the Activity Center for those unable to sit in the Worship Center.
- Physical distancing in ministries to minors is encouraged but not always feasible or practical.
- Ongoing conversation and social interaction is encouraged to take place outside of the building when practical.

Cleaning/Sanitizing

- The Worship Center, Activity Center, foyer and restrooms are sanitized weekly.
- Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer are available throughout the building for sanitizing hands and high-touch surfaces
- Water fountains will be restricted to bottle filling only. Cups are also available.

BCLR Kids and AWANA

- KidCheck label printers are available in the foyer and at the foyer entrance to the BCLR Kids nursery area.
- A check-in kiosk is available in the foyer for those who do not have or are unable to use the KidCheck app.
- Only one guardian may enter the BCLR Kids nursery area for drop-off and pickup.
- All AWANA clubbers must be picked up from their classrooms.
- Class sizes are maintained at 10 or fewer children per class.

Standard Health Screening - Anyone checking in children to BCLR Kids or entering the BCLR Kids nursery area must have their temperature taken and answer the following screening questions with "no":

- *In the last 14 days, are you aware of being in contact with anyone who has tested positive for the Coronavirus?*
- *Have you tested positive for the Coronavirus in the last 14 days?*
- *Have you had a fever, cough, pneumonia or flu-like symptoms in the last 2 weeks?*

A Note About These Procedures - The procedures above do not cover every possible scenario; there may be exceptions to most or all of them. Face coverings and physical distancing have proven to be especially divisive issues. Thus it is imperative at all times that we exercise love, brotherly affection and common sense toward one another even as we seek to be prudent regarding the coronavirus and appropriately respectful of guidances released by governing authorities.
