OPENING ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED: Hand sanitizer, large marshmallows, wet wipes, disposable cups and/or blocks, (optional) construction paper, wax paper, or another surface kids can build on

WHAT YOU DO:

- Help kids pair up. If possible, pair older kids with younger ones.
- Guide kids to apply hand sanitizer.
- Give each team about 20 marshmallows.
- Challenge kids to build the tallest marshmallow wall that they can by stacking them. Praise teams for their cooperation, creativity, and problemsolving skills!
- Provide wet wipes when the kids finish—they'll likely need them!
- If you have extra, untouched marshmallows, you might choose to give kids a small treat!
- Next, provide other building materials such as disposable cups or blocks.
- Challenge teams to build the tallest wall they can with the new items.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"You guys did a great job of working together to build your walls! Which wall was the tallest? Which wall was the STRONGEST? Why do you think so? (Pause for ideas.) Good thinking! [Transition] In Large Group, we'll hear what a VERY strong wall and God's plan have in common. Let's go learn more."

Lead your group to the Large Group area.

1. GOD'S PLAN IS THE BEST PLAN [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Blow Your Horn" Activity Page, scissors, markers, crayons and/or stickers, tape

WHAT YOU DO:

- Invite each kid to choose an Activity Page.
- Lead kids to point to each word as you read the Bottom Line aloud.
- Next, show kids where to cut along the lines.
- Set out scissors and guide kids to cut where shown. Provide assistance as needed.
- Invite kids to decorate their pages with the markers, crayons, and/or stickers.
- When each kid finishes, show them how they can roll their page and overlap the ends and tape them together to make a trumpet.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"What do you remember about trumpets from our Bible story today? (The Israelite priests blew trumpets when they marched around Jericho.) Even though God's plan for the Israelites to march around Jericho, blow trumpets, and shout didn't make sense, Joshua and the Israelites obeyed. They had CONFIDENCE that God's plan was the BEST plan.

[Make It Personal] (Tell kids about a time in your life when God's plan was the best plan, even though you may not have understood it at first. You might tell kids about when you moved to a new city, learned to do something that was challenging at first, or experienced something that you didn't understand. Tell kids how God grew your confidence in Him through the experience.)

"You can have confidence that **God's plan is the best plan**, too. You can have confidence that **God's plan is the best plan** when you move to a new home and have to make new friends. You can have confidence that **God's plan is the best plan** when you don't get the teacher you want at school. And you can have confidence that **God's plan is the best plan** when something seems confusing or hard to do. No matter what, **God's plan is the best plan!**"

*2. MARCH!

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible marked at Joshua 6; (optional) "trumpets" kids made in "God's Plan Is the Best Plan" Activity #1

WHAT YOU DO:

- Invite a volunteer to open the Bible where marked. Read verses 2 through 5 aloud.
- Lead kids to dramatize the story.
 - If your group is large enough, choose one kid to be Joshua, two or more kids to be the "walls of Jericho," and the remaining kids to be the "priests" and "Israelites."
 - If your group is smaller, designate a table or other object to be "Jericho."
- Direct "Joshua" to lead the "priests" and the "Israelites" to walk around the city once, with the priests blowing their trumpets. (Kids can use the trumpets they made in "God's Plan Is the Best Plan.")
- Guide kids to "return to camp and go to sleep." Do this for six "days," designating a new "Joshua" for each day.
- On the seventh day, lead kids to march around Jericho seven times. Excitedly count each lap!
- After the seventh lap, direct "Joshua" to tell the people to give a loud shout. At this shout, the "walls" of Jericho will fall.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Did Joshua and the Israelites follow God's plan? Yes, they did! Even though they didn't know WHY God wanted them to march around the city for SEVEN days, they knew that **God's plan is the best plan**, so they obeyed.

"Is it always good to obey God? Yes! You know, sometimes God's plans are easy to follow, and sometimes they don't make sense. [Make It Personal] (Share about a time when you obeyed God and later saw that His plan was best. It might be a time when something didn't go the way you expected, a time when God told you to do something that didn't make sense, or a time when God used a challenging situation for good.)

"So, when God's plans don't seem to make sense, remember that GOD is GOOD. Remember that **God's plan is the best plan!** And remember that His plan is for you to live the way He wants us to live, even when the plan doesn't make sense, yet."

PRAY AND DISMISS

[PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "God's Plan" Activity Page

WHAT YOU DO:

- Lead kids to gather in a circle and hold hands, if possible.
- Use the conversation below to guide kids in a responsive

prayer.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"The important thing to remember today is this. (Hold up the Activity Page and point to each word as you say it.) God's plan is the best plan. Say it with me. God's plan is the best plan. Let's pray. (Lead kids to echo the Bottom Line after you.)

"Dear God, Your plan is the best plan."

KIDS: "God's plan is the best plan."

LEADER: "When we're confused, Your plan is the best plan."

KIDS: "God's plan is the best plan."

LEADER: "When things don't make sense, Your plan is the best plan."

KIDS: "God's plan is the best plan."

LEADER: "Thank You that no matter what, Your plan is the best plan.

KIDS: "God's plan is the best plan."


LEADER: "You are SO good. Your plan is the best plan."

Joshua listened to the plans God made and it was so much better than he could have imagined! Ask God to help you this week when things don't go as planned.

"Dear God, Sometimes I think I have a really good idea and it doesn't work. I can get super disappointed and upset. Please remind me of the story of Joshua and the walls of Jericho. Thank you for having the best plan. Amen." 3

Grab an adult and look up Jeremiah 29:11. Read it together a few times. Now, look for the word "success" or "prosper" within the verse. With a parent, ask these questions: What have you done in your life that has been a success? What is something at which you want to succeed? Imagine all you can do if you make God part of your plan!
