PRAYING FOR THE NATIONS



"Life-on-life discipleship"
-- spending extended

means to be a disciple of Jesus. The Youngs' ministry in Argentina is primarily focused on making disciples of Jesus, life on life, with an emphasis on helping others to live out their faith in the context God has placed them among the lost with the vision of passing along what they have received to the next generation of seekers and believers. Along with their country leader, they are trusting God to expand the ministry outside the province of Buenos Aires by taking initiatives in a new city over 500 miles away.

Chris and Flor also serve as part of the Navigators leadership team in Latin America, giving them the opportunity to utilize their gifts with some of the key leaders in countries like Chile, Uruguay, Brazil, Venezuela, Peru, Ecuador, Costa Rica, Guatemala and Mexico.

MISSIONS IN ACTION

One former Muslim shared, "I had a dream in which a man in white robes spoke to me. He asked me to believe in Him. The next day, the dream came back again. In the dream, I asked Him who He was. And He said, 'I am Jesus.' Unlike other dreams, this was very vivid, and would not go away. It was so real and powerful. I was in the university. I had Christian friends, so I asked them about the dream. And after they shared about Christ, I believed in Him. After seven years, my father came to know about it. At that point, he was so angry he wanted to kill me. He took his gun and fired at me. But the gun did not go off, and I ran away. I have not gone back to my parental home since then. I keep in touch with my siblings only."

E and K -

E and K are church planters in North Africa. K works with a ministry that serves women who were victims of human trafficking. E is the director of a ministry called PALM (Preparing Arab-world Leaders for Ministry). PALM is a discipleship and leadership training ministry for believers from a Muslim background (BMBs) serving believers throughout North Africa, the Middle East, and the Arab diaspora. PALM works in close partnership with local national churches (where they exist) training godly leaders towards church multiplication.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

- That they will be the hands, feet, tone, and words of Christ to their neighbors and be the light of Jesus as they live in utter darkness.
- For the team he leads-that even amidst the constant challenges, they are able to train and mentor national leaders in the Arab world and beyond.
- For the ability to teach, disciple, and equip believers from a Muslim background towards church multiplication.

K and N -

They are pioneer church planters in the Middle East with a strong emphasis on bi-vocational ministry. KC has a job as a university and professional sports coach and gets to mentor and pre-disciple 150 young men in his program.

NC spends several days a week directing a refugee program for African and Middle Eastern Migrants. This is a wholistic program that meets the physical and spiritual needs of young women during the most trying times of their lives. They have been able to serve nearly 400 women on a regular basis throughout the year, getting to know these women at a deeper level, helping them to thrive in a transitional city for many of them.


They have regularly served in leadership at local indigenous churches and international churches and helped church planting efforts through these ministries. KC has served as an Elder throughout different seasons and has been an active participant in the church planting teams.



MISSIONS IN ACTION

For the last 10 months, E has met with a group via Zoom. Other times he meets 1:1 with group members. Weekly they study God's Word and go through the PALM discipleship material. There is obvious growth in Christ,

increased knowledge of God's love, a clear desire to know Him more and mature in their faith. Through discipleship and mentoring discussions, the group has now formed a house church, with their own identity, leadership, name, and even a logo! They are now in the process of multiplying, planting 2 new churches in 2 new cities!



E and E -

Facilitate Scripture engagement in multiple countries and in many languages. They are now working harder than ever with more ministry fruit witnessed than ever before. They facilitate training, resource development and support services worldwide in four areas — all based on a model of conversational, personal and biblical storytelling or "storyweaving" that multiplies well across cultures and is always locally sustainable.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

- For South Asian Weavers team leaders who are in very difficult "climates" for Christ-followers.
- For God's protection as each one "weaves" in their community due to significant opposition from those of the dominant faith.
- For confirmation of God's leading, planning, mentoring and that those training to go will be blessed with faithful prayer and financial partners.

Jand J -

J and J serve indigenous and expat church planters and church leaders in Asia by helping them understand and experience how the grace of Christ is at work, not just through their ministries but also in their own lives.

After being so abruptly expelled by national security in 2020, they returned to the States. After 2 years, they are now preparing to leave to their new country of ministry. They will continue their involvement with equipping ministers in other countries, as well as seeking to serve others locally.

PRAYER REQUESTS

- Wisdom, patience, continued strengthening of their faith as they wait to leave for their new location.
- That their children will adjust well emotionally to the move.
- That they will find a support system in their new location that will help make for a smooth transition.

T and A -

T & A help the local house church and leadership to health and maturity in Christ by emphasizing and modeling certain aspects of the Christian life. Due to growing scrutiny and hostility towards Christians and foreigners, they focus on one-on-one or couple to couple discipling, mentoring, counseling, and investment in the lives of existing or potential leaders.

AFRICA NEW LIFE

RWANDA

Since its beginning in 2001, Africa New Life has partnered with local churches to impact children of Rwanda and energize congregations. As a result:
--11,000 students are now

sponsored!

--Churches have been built.

--Medical care is being administered.

--Pastors are being educated.

--Bellies are being filled.

--Widows are receiving vocational training.

--Hope is being restored

and lives are being transformed.

Founded by Rwandans and staffed primarily by Rwandans, Africa New Life focuses purely on ministry without cultural barriers in two main areas: proclaiming the gospel and acts of compassion, thereby providing for the bodies and souls of its brothers and sisters in Rwanda.

The ministry's New Life Christian Academy was named the top secondary school in Rwanda in 2011, beating out 1,060 other schools. This resulted in the Rwandan government asking Africa New Life to run two different public schools. Its Africa College of Theology opened in January 2013 and offers college-level training to current and future pastors and other ministry leaders from Rwanda and surrounding nations.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

- Pray for the churches in Rwanda. New regulations set by the Rwandan parliament in July 2018 require all pastors to acquire and hold a bachelor's or higher level of training in theology or a similar field something the majority of pastors in the nation cannot afford to do. Without this education, they will not be allowed to lead congregations or plant churches. The need for affordable, accessible theological training in Rwanda is, therefore, higher than ever. Through God's provision, Africa College of Theology (ACT) is one of the only evangelical institutions in the nation offering an accredited bachelor's degrees in theology and Bible. - Pray for all the summer team trips to Rwanda. We facilitate many team trips to Rwanda year-round, but summer is a very busy season. Pray for the health of staff and travelers, that God would be found -- even by those who are not looking -- and that people would see God's faithfulness and provision, as well as the opportunity to join Him in His work in Africa, and ask Him for the courage to move forward.

Rio Bravo REYNOSA, MEXICO

Created from a junkyard across the border into Mexico and approximately five miles from McAllen, Texas, Rio Bravo Ministries (RBM) is led by Pastor Ray Hansen and his wife Leah. This walled compound on six acres contains the Casa Hogar Children's Home that is home to 60 children and an elementary school. The second

compound, located in a poor area, has a Junior & High School, and the combined population of children on both campuses has approximately 750 children. They are the largest schools in Reynosa. On mission trips, AOC adults and students work on projects ranging from painting, landscaping, paving and staining to participating with local people through sports, food service, language classes, chapel and other activities. Recurring mission trips establish ongoing relationships with the opportunity for deepening involvement, cross

cultural experience, a gratifying and visible impact as well as easy access and accessible cost.

- Pray for a new boy 13 yrs old named Nicolas for his salvation.
 He comes from a very difficult background.
- Pray for our four sets of houseparents to continue to be strong as they lead their homes in Christian love.

Harvest Children's Home

CAMEROON, AFRICA

Cry Cameroon USA is a ministry committed to rescuing orphaned children and supporting ongoing Christian ministries in Cameroon. Harvest Children's Home is an orphanage near Fundong, Cameroon founded and supported by Cry Cameroon USA.

Harvest Children's Home
(HCH) was founded in
1992 as a feeding station
which grew into a Christ
centered orphanage housing up
to 75 children at a time who have
lost one or both

parents with no other means of support. HCH

staff and partners show the love of Jesus by providing education, health, shelter, and nutritional care to the children as well as spiritual and Biblical guidance. Cry Cameroon also partners with churches, social services, and community leaders across Cameroon to serve local communities offering

Biblical training, healthcare, clean water, evangelism, job opportunities, and connections with social services. Soon, partners will be able to participate in establishing HCH 2.0 near Yaoundé, Cameroon.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

- For favor with communities and government in support of their projects.
- For peace in the region and an end to the civil war in the Northwest province (near HCH)
- For clear direction and funding of HCH 2.0 near Yaoundé, Cameroon
