Dear Missions Partner,

First, thank you for your prayers, participation, and partnership over the past several years. We are excited to have the first round of construction nearing a completion. Here is where we stand on some major components:

- Only He Gets The Glory – the new religious non-profit that will oversee The Light Community has been established. All the necessary legal paperwork has been filed. We have established a board of directors.
- Wastewater – the pieces of the puzzle are going in, a little slower than planned, but nevertheless, progress! The installers are having to battle some weather issues, scheduling conflicts, and supply issues. But, we are seeing progress.
- Electrical – two houses have been roughed in and passed inspection. These two triggered the power company to come move power lines and poles for all the houses! We are prayerfully waiting resources for the continued rough ins.
- Plumbing – one house rough in inspected and another is scheduled to be roughed in this week.
- Houses – we currently have 10 houses and the laundry house that all have been dried in. All painting and staining should be complete the first week of summer missions.
- The Prayer Chapel – all storage has been moved. We have the wood floor install and finished. In addition, we have new to us wood chairs that have been repainted white. Chapel needs a mini-split, insulation panels in the ceiling, and metal underpinning. We are excited to host groups this summer in the prayer chapel.
- Gardening and land – gardens are in and doing well. The green house has been a huge blessing! All the wood fencing has been painted as well.



Now is the time to come and help finish the houses. We are working on the interior of each house throughout the summer and continuing until all the work is complete. If your church has started a house, we invite you to come finish the interior. Other ground up construction projects include one more loft house, mission bunk house, office, and barn.

In addition to construction, we can use more financial partnership to purchase the finishing of each house. This includes appliances, mini-splits, water heaters, cabinets, fixtures, and more. Donations are still handled through Crossroads Community Baptist Church. Each house requires \$2000 for rough in plumbing and up to \$2000 for rough in electrical.



Our goal is to open more houses through the summer as we get them complete. Missions occurs all year! We welcome teams of any size and any length of time.
