From the very beginning in Genesis (Genesis 3:15), God had a plan for our salvation. A plan that prioritized his love for us as his precious creation.

## **Board of Property Report:** Bill Borchardt shared the following report for the months of June & July:

- Storage Shed (Randy) and Stage Renovation – On Hold until building materials come down in price.
- Fire Extinguishers for electronic fires have been placed in the balcony. We are also looking into smoke detectors that would hook up to our security camera system and WIFI capable to alert us if there is a fire in the church.
- Chandeliers – Jen has gotten estimates for the new chandeliers. The one we like best is \$600 per fixture, without installation, and the second one we liked was \$1200 per fixture without installation. We are working on getting installation cost and seeing if we can do it ourselves or not.
- Narthex renovation – We scheduled another work day to work on demo of the church offices for Aug 12th, and Sept 11th.
- Storage for coffee bar –Randy is working on getting the pullout shelves and get them installed.
- Urinals – Automatic flushers are on orders and will be installed by Dennis when they arrive.
- Add more guard pipes outside the childcare room (where Pastor parks) to protect those pipes on the side of the school. Randy will be working on this.
- Cole said he will be able to fill in the brick areas where the old heating units are.

# EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

- Bulbs for front of church – Pastor got 4 LED bulbs and we tried them to make sure the spectrum of light was good, we are good and he is ordering enough bulbs to replace all flood lights in front of church and balcony.
- New signs for No Smoking, No Vaping and No E-cigarettes On Property will be installed where the old signs are located.
- Randy is cleaning up and getting the bookshelves in the library room of church operational so they can be utilized for a library again, and will put a keyed lock on one of the cabinets to house Script material that stays at church.
- The board also discussed the possibility of upgrading the lawnmower. One thought was to get a zero turn 60” mower to speed up the process for the volunteers. We discussed the pro’s and con’s and will look at this one more time at our next meeting.

**Financial Updates:** Ross Corey shared the following report for the months of June & July:

Checking Account balance as of July 31, 2021 is \$63,521. Designated (Held in Savings) balance is \$146,701.

June 2021 offerings were \$30,395, compared with \$32,172 in June 2020. Total June income was \$36,121 including offerings, other, and Thrivent Choice. Total expenses paid in June were \$26,725.

July 2021 offerings were \$28,322, compared with \$26,495 in July 2020. Total July income was \$38,827 including offerings, other, and Thrivent Choice. Total expenses paid in July were \$28,731.

The balance for the Board of Property's account is \$11,154 as of July 31st.
