Registration

Your child must reach the age of 3, 4, or 5, (depending upon the class chosen), by <u>August 31^{st.}</u> We may opt to enroll your child on a trial basis to ascertain whether he or she is developmentally ready to begin the class chosen. If we feel your child would benefit by waiting another year, your money may be refunded. We will also inform you if we feel your child should be advanced to a class to best suit his/her developmental needs.

Registration Fee

\$150.00 (Non-refundable, due at the time of registration)

The registration fee is used for curriculum supplies needed throughout the year, special activities, end of the year t-shirts, projects, and field trips.

Book Fees (Non- refundable, due at the time of registration)

3/4's Class: No Book Fee Due

K4 Class: \$150

Children enrolled in all K4 classes will purchase a complete book set from Abeka Book Curriculum. Materials not used during the school year will be sent home.

Kindergarten Class: \$210

Children enrolled in all Kindergarten classes will purchase a complete book set from Abeka Book Curriculum. Materials not used during the school year will be sent home.

- ** Students will not be allowed to register until the following criteria has been met:
 - Registration Fee paid in full
 - Book Fee paid in full
 - Registration Packet filled out in its entirety
 - Updated and signed copy of your child's Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS)
 - Parent Agreement signed

Explanation of Classes:

<u>3/4-year-old class</u>: Best suited for children who are 3 years old by August 31st or turned 4 years old in the months of June, July, and August of 2022. All students must be potty trained. This class is held Monday through Friday. The class begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 11:30 a.m. Students can attend 2 to 5 days per week depending on available space.

<u>K4 class</u>: Best suited for children who are 4 years old and are going to kindergarten the following year. This class is held Monday through Friday. The class begins at 8:45 a.m. and ends at 11:45 a.m. Students can attend 3 to 5 days per week depending on available space.

<u>Kindergarten class</u>: Best suited for students who have reached the <u>age of 5 by August 31st</u>. This class is held Monday through Friday. The class begins at 8:45 a.m. and ends at 12:00 noon. Students are required to attend Monday through Friday. The year is broken into four quarters, with grades and attendance being reported each quarter for school records.

**Each child will be assessed during a meet and greet time prior to the school year starting. Your child's teacher will assist in placing your child in the class that will best suit their needs.

Tuition

This year classes begin on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>August 31st</u> for Kindergarten, and <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 6th</u> for Preschool. Classes will end on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>June 7th</u>.

*The per-year cost considers the days we have off for Christmas, Spring Break, holidays, and potential closures for church functions.

Payment is expected by the 1st of each month. A late fee of \$20 will be added on the 15th day of the month unless other arrangements are made with our bookkeeper. Your child will not be allowed to participate in class after the 25th with a delinquent account unless suitable payment arrangements can be made. A \$35 NSF fee will be charged for any form of payment returned for insufficient funds.

 An extra 5% payment discount will be taken if the entire school year is paid in advance. If for any reason you choose to withdraw your child before the end of the year, a refund will be given based upon the discounted rate paid and the normal rate that should have been charged. A \$10.00 per month tuition discount will be given for each additional sibling.

Tuition Fees

Your first payment will be due September 1st, and the final payment will be due May 1st. Any student with an overdue account may not participate in graduation exercises.
