

Impact Camp 2021 Dress Code

The most important thing to remember is to dress modestly, so that Christ will be honored. Those students wearing inappropriate clothing, including clothing that is too tight, low, short, or high-cut, will be asked to change.

Daily Activities:

- No strapless, midriff, open-back, tube-top, halter-top, or lowcut shirts allowed.
- Tanks and spaghetti-strap tank tops **are permitted with a modest undershirt.**
- Shirt arm holes must circle directly underneath armpit.
- Undergarments are to be worn at all times.
- Shorts must be modest in length.
- Spandex leggings or pants must be worn with shorts or a long shirt completely covering the rear at all times
- Shorts or pants with writing on rear-end are not allowed.

Swimming/Slide:

- Shorts and t-shirts must be worn as a cover up to and from the pool area and water games.
- Girls & Boys: T-Shirt must be worn over swimsuit in pool area at all times

Evening Services:

- Girls: dresses, skirts, pants, Capri pants, longer shorts, and jeans are appropriate for evening services.
- No strapless dresses are allowed.
- Modest undershirts **must** be worn under CROP TOPS, spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
- Skirts, dresses and shorts **must** be modest in length, including slits.
- Boys: pants, jeans, and longer shorts are appropriate.
