The First Presbyterian Church of Everett invites all who enter this building or return to meet in person to join in a Covenant of Care for one another in order to demonstrate our love of God and neighbor, especially for those who are most vulnerable to COVID-19. The leadership of FPCE is monitoring and working on reasonable measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. These are the core practices we affirm to reduce known risks of COVID-19 virus transmission as we re-enter our building and engage in-person activities. We ask for your commitment to join in this effort by signing this document that will be kept on file in our office. This covenant only needs to be signed once.

Our covenant binds us together in the goal of safely reopening our facility.
I agree to help reduce disease transmission by:

Compassionate Distancing

- Staying at home if I am sick (or have been with someone who has symptoms of sickness)
- Properly wearing a mask at all times within the building
- Keeping proper social distance of six feet between myself and others whenever possible
- Sitting with my household in designated areas

Doing Things Differently

- Checking in every time I enter the church building
- Greeting others without touching them, virtual and air hugs are encouraged!
- Praising God without singing
- Keeping children of my household beside me in worship
- Comply with any additional safety measures as directed by FPCE staff or leaders

Disinfecting

- Washing and/or sanitizing my hands after checking in to the church building, touching surfaces, and using the bathroom

I agree to be patient and respectful of requests made by church leaders for our safety. I recognize that some members of our community are at increased risk of contracting COVID-19 and I want to contribute to a positive environment of care and concern for one another.
