PS – Find a translation of the Bible you feel comfortable with and grab a writing instrument. I'm daring you to write in the margins, highlight a verse, circle a word that means something to you now and date it, so when you come back you can go, 'oh, that spoke to me then, and now this part is.' This is a great way to remind ourselves where God has been faithful and note growth in our discipleship.

Restart

This reading plan for the month is for families and those just wondering where to begin. Each week in June has a parable and another story from scripture. There's no pressure for something daily, just read, reflect, draw, write, and pray through these verses.

June 7 - 13: Parable of the Sower Mark 4:1-20; Genesis 1

June 14 – 20: Parable of the Lost Sheep Matthew 18:10-14; 1 Samuel 17:1-11, 38-49

June 21 – 27: Parable of the Good Samaritan Luke 10:25-37; Jonah 1

June 28 – July 4: Parable of Mustard Seed Mark 4:30-32; 1 Kings 19:9-13

Gearing Up

This reading plan for the month is for those wanting a little more, but may not want daily verses. Each week in June will have three readings and a verse to memorize. Again, the hope is you read, reflect, memorize, journal, and pray through these verses.

June 7 – 13: Mark 6:30-44, Genesis 1, Psalm 100; memorize Psalm 46:10a

June 14 – 20: John 1:1-14, Jonah 1&2; memorize Proverbs 3:5-6

June 21 – 27: 1 Corinthians 13, Jonah 3&4; memorize John 3:16-17

June 28 – July 4: Romans 8, Isaiah 6; memorize Galatians 5:22-23
