



## **Confirmation Program Roadmap**

**2021-2022**

For 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade Youth

Our confirmation program is split up into three parts, each preparing students for their next step in their spiritual journey of baptism or confirming their baptismal vows. These three parts can be taken in a single year or split between multiple years depending on your youth's needs.

- Each part will be held on Sunday mornings from 11:15am-12:15pm in the Youth Room.
- Lunch will be included.
- We encourage parents to participate with their youth in Parts 1 and 2!

### **Confirmation Part 1 –Bible Basics**

Three weeks in September (12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>)

Week 2: "What is in the Bible?"

Week 3: "How do I read the Bible?"

### **Confirmation Part 2 – Church Pillars**

Three weeks in November (7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>)

Week 1: "What is the Apostles' Creed?"

Week 2: "What is the Lord's Prayer?"

Week 3: "What are the Ten Commandments?"
