

**Hillcrest Church Family,**

**The Times, They Are a-Changin'**

Bob Dylan released this title track on his 1964 album of the same name as a deliberate attempt to create an anthem of change occurring at the time of its composition. What was true then is even more true today. However, the radical difference is that, as believers in Christ, we are uniquely postured for these times of transition and adjustment through our faith which must override our fears.

In a recent audio recording which I sent out to our church family via email, I outlined several practical ways that we can respond during these times of change in our culture and our changing forms of communication. I would like to review them again for a wider audience as we prepare for Resurrection Sunday – EASTER! Mark 16:5-7 (NIV) - *As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed. "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'"*

Some simple suggestions for spiritual strength in these times:

- Sit Up! God has given us an opportunity to move from complacency and routine to a new level of sensitivity, focus and attention. Let's listen to His voice carefully.
- Stretch Out! God is stretching us and allowing us all to be in a new learning curve as we stretch our emotions, are electronic-savvy, communications, our levels of energy - all while seeking to avoid exhaustion. Let's learn together.
- Stand Up! God does not expect us to hide or hunker-down during these days. We must look for new and better ways to share the Gospel through caring and boldness with one another and others. Let's stand tall for His glory.
- Shut up! I do not like this term or use it publicly, but it serves as a reminder that with so many opinions and so many voices shouting at us, that we would do well not to blame or defame. Let's zip our lips from preferences and prejudice.
- Look Up! God is able, God is ready, and God is waiting on us. If we are so busy looking around and down, we might miss it. Let's believe as one body seeking the face of God.

He is risen, indeed!




**Worship Service Schedule**
