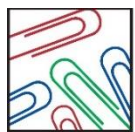

Detailed instructions about online giving are included in this newsletter. We hope this will help you as you try to use this service.

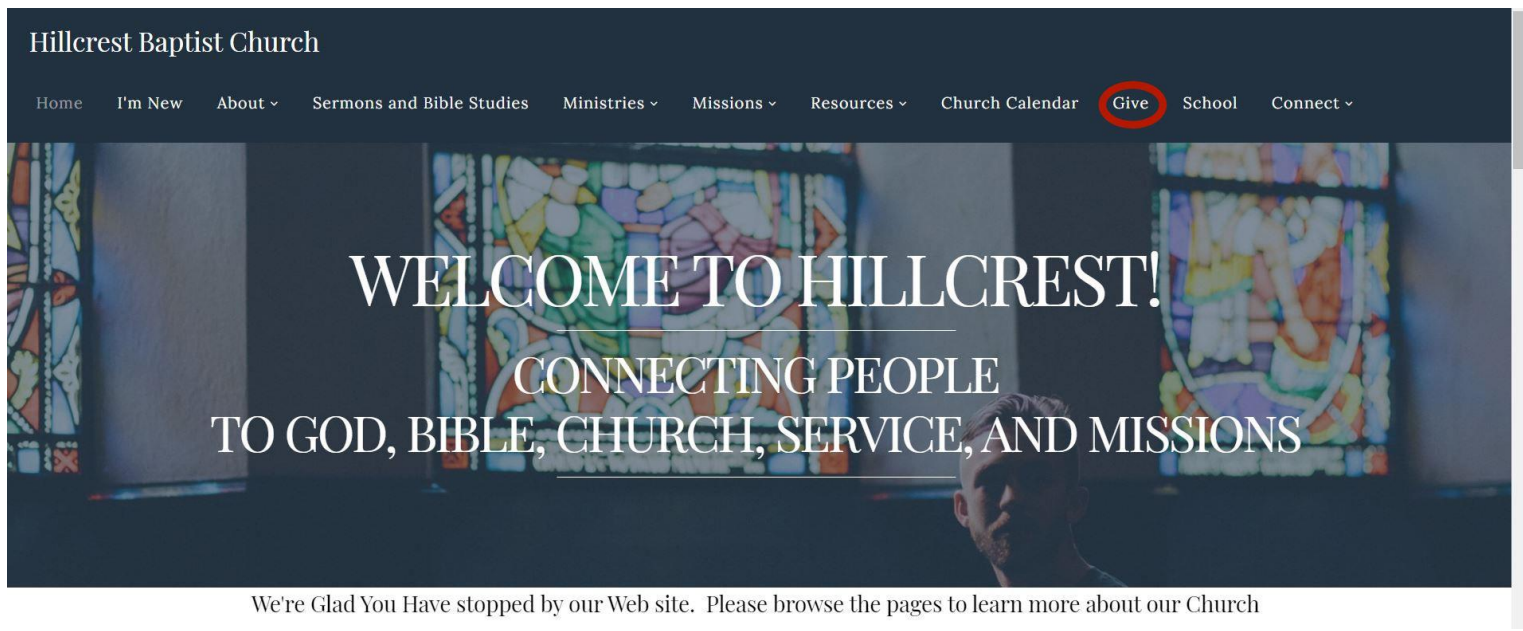

Instructions for Online Giving

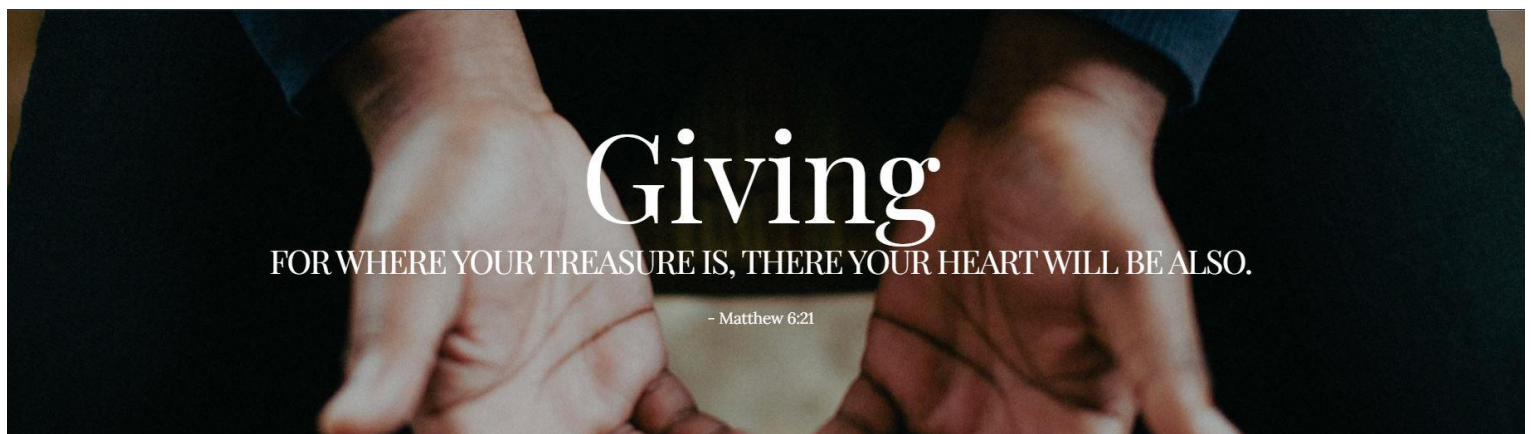
During this time when we are away from our normal time together for worship, we hope you are continuing to be faithful in your giving of your tithes and offerings.
