Jesus wants us to understand these principles about God’s kingdom:

1. God's Kingdom starts with humility.
 - ❖ Consider the “upstart.”
 - ❖ Remember what happens “under fire.”
 - ❖ Know that it was “unto death.”

2. God's Kingdom work is not necessarily seen.
 - ❖ It's in secret - without fanfare.
 - ❖ It's in synchronization - working together.
 - ❖ It's through saturation - affecting all.

3. God's Kingdom comes from the outside.
 - ❖ With a purpose
 - ❖ To follow a plan
 - ❖ Expressed through power

- YOU are a part of God's plan to make it happen?




