

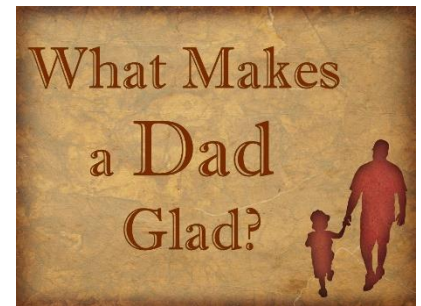

Guidelines for Returning to Worship in the Sanctuary

We are looking forward to worshipping with you again. Please follow the following guidelines as you enter the building.

Worship Service at 11:00 AM.

- **Worship Service Access**
 - Please respect other's personal distance as you enter and exit the Worship Center.
 - Entry and Exit through the front of Worship Center.
 - Doors will be propped open during arrival and dismissal.
- **Social Distancing** (It is a personal responsibility, not a personal choice.)
 - No handshakes or hugs. Share a holy wave or nod of joy.
 - Family units seated together.
 - Socially distanced rows will be established with marked areas.
- **Sanitation and Cleaning**
 - Sanitation Stations/areas and wipes will be available.
 - Doors will be propped open during entry and exit from the building.
 - Giving stations for offerings will be utilized instead of plates passed.
 - Sanitation of all utilized facilities between services.
- **Masks are strongly recommended, not required. Available upon entry if needed.**
- **No Nursery, Childcare, or Small Groups on Sunday morning.**
- **Please remain at home in accordance with Georgia's shelter-in-place order if you have any medical condition. Online access to our services will be provided via Facebook and our Website. Sermon Notes for Sunday, June 21, 2020

Listen UP! Series

"What Makes A Dad Glad?" - I John 2:12-14

Father's Day is a special time to reflect on the gift of life. Our physical life and our spiritual life have obvious parallels. Let's look at several reasons from our scripture today.

1. Because he is grateful. (v.12)
 - for the "born ones" (dear children)
 - for the forgiveness of sins
 - for the power of His name
2. Because some are grown. (vv. 13a, 14a)
 - as mature in knowledge - (ginoska = know by experience)
 - as leaders following the Leader - ("from the beginning")
3. Because some are growing. (vv. 13b; 14b)
 - as devil defeaters - ("overcome"/"strong")
 - with the Word as a weapon - ("logos")
4. Because some are groping. (v.13c)
 - as immature ones
 - as children under authority

Here's how to make God glad:

- **Realize You are lost without a Father. (sin)**
- **Recognize You need a Father. (forgiveness)**
- **Respond You must ask the Father. (prayer)**
- **Receive You must trust the Father. (obey)**
