## APPLICATION QUESTIONS

“Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.” James 1:22 NIV

### SUMMARY

Pastor Frank taught a message entitled, “Lost Boys?!” from John 10:22-42. In the passage, Jesus pointed His listeners to both His words and His works as evidence that He was the Son of God. Some believed while others wanted to stone Him for blasphemy.

### APPLICATION

- 1. The Jews couldn't believe His words, so Jesus pointed them to His works (v.25).**
  - With all that we know about Jesus and His word today, why do you think it is still so difficult for some people to believe the words of Christ in our day?
  - Who comes to mind in your life who cannot bring themselves to believe in Jesus and His word? How do you interact with this person?
- 2. In verse 28, Jesus cites some of the amazing benefits of following Him.**
  - Based on this verse, what are the benefits of following Christ? What is eternal life?
  - What reasons have you heard and/or have people have given you as to why they wouldn't want to enjoy such wonderful benefits?
  - If no one can snatch those of us who believe out of God's hand, why do you think there is so much fear in the church today? How might we better overcome our fears?
- 3. Jesus “disarmed” his accusers with a couple of well asked questions (vv.31-37)**
  - Why do you think Jesus' use of questions in these verses was so powerful?
  - Have you ever “disarmed” someone using questions? If so what happened?
- 4. In summary, Jesus was rejected both for speaking and living out the truth.**
  - On a scale from 1 to 10, how would you say you are doing at both speaking and living out the truth? Which area are stronger in?
  - How might this small group help you to grown in your area of weakness?

### PRAYER

Pray that the Lord will empower our words to better match our works through the power of His spirit.
