13 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, 14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

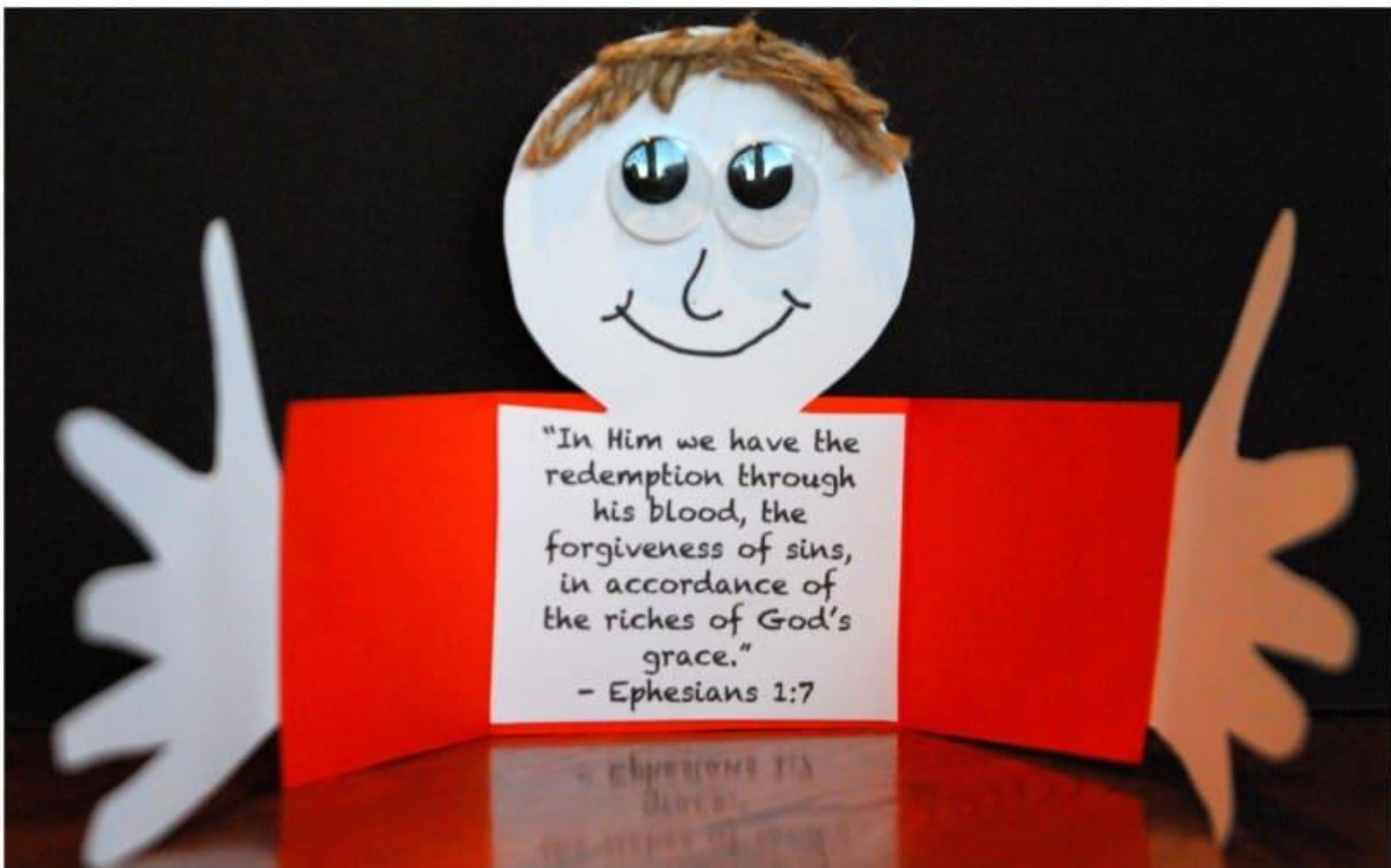
**Big Picture Question:** How does God care for His creation?

### Parable of the Lost Son

1. Fold the 3" by 11" strip of cardstock into thirds
  - a) If online, cut a 3" by 11" stripe of cardstock and fold into thirds
2. Cut out the head/verse template
3. Have the child(ren) draw around both of their hands and cut them out
4. Now glue down the verse/head and hands
5. Color the hair and eyes if you like



The arms open wide with a willingness to forgive. The hands interlock to show a big embrace as the son returns to the father.

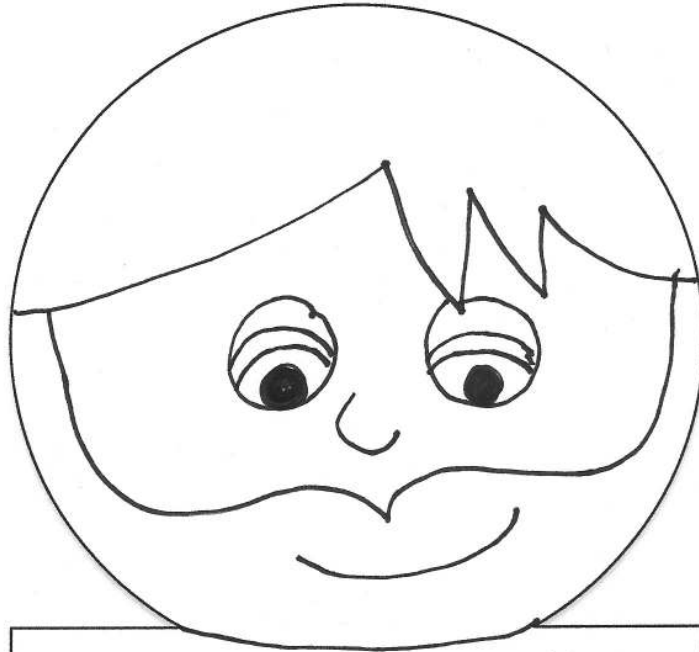
We are all sinners and can only come into God's presence because of His abundant forgiveness and grace. ~Enjoy~
