HEBREWS: JESUS IS BETTER

“The Living and Active Word of God”

1. Read Hebrews 4:12-13 together. Was there anything from the text or from the sermon that particularly stood out to you? What was the main point of the passage? For kids: if you had to summarize one thing you learned, what would it be?
 2. How do these verses fit into the context of everything we have seen in the book of Hebrews so far?
 3. Discuss what it means for the Word to be *alive*. Then, discuss what it means for the Word to be *active*.
 4. Verse 13 talks about how the Word of God exposes us, which might sound like a daunting or even threatening thing. But how is this actually good news? Why would we *want* to be exposed by the Word? (Jeremiah 17:9 might be a good reminder)
 5. What are some practical ways to put these truths into practice, giving ourselves to the Word of God for our own greater joy and rest?
