INITIAL PLANS FOR RETURNING TO FBC SELMER



- Starting May 17, 2020, we will meet for worship on Sunday mornings at our Main Campus and the North Campus.
 - o At the main campus, we will have two morning worship services at 8:45 a.m. & 10:00 a.m.
 - The 8:45 a.m. worship service will be reserved for **SENIOR ADULTS** and individuals who have pre-existing risk factors that require a smaller gathering.
 - The 10:00 a.m. worship service will be open to ALL OTHER WORSHIPPERS.
 - Social distancing precautions will be followed at all morning worship services.
 - At the Main Campus, alternating **pews will be blocked off** to allow for appropriate distancing between worshippers.
 - All worshippers are encouraged to sit with family members (those you live in the same house with) but allow proper distance with others who are sitting on the same pew.
 - At the North Campus, appropriate spacing will be provided (and maintained) between chairs.
 - All worshippers are encouraged to use designated ENTRANCES & EXITS.
 - > Senior adults and those with pre-existing risk factors are encouraged to enter and exit the church facility through the side entrance near the elevator.
 - All other worshippers are encouraged to use the front entrance of the sanctuary or the drive-through entrance.
 - o The 8:45 a.m. worship service at the North Campus will be moved to 10:00 a.m.
 - THE WAREHOUSE WORSHIP SERVICE WILL MOVE TO THE NORTH CAMPUS so that proper social distancing can be provided. The Warehouse service will be at 11:00 a.m.
 - Efforts to sanitize common areas will be provided before, between, & after worship services.
- Nursery will NOT be provided at any of our campuses.
- For now, Small Groups/Sunday School classes will not meet on campus but will connect each Sunday through the Zoom App or by other methods.
- There will be **No Wednesday night** activities until further notice. Wednesday night small groups are encouraged to meet on the Zoom App or by some other means.
- All summer trips have been postponed. Depending upon the recommendations from government officials, summer activities (previously) scheduled will also be postponed.
