## Piatt County Toy and Gift

The Piatt County Toy and Gift program is entering its 37th year of providing toys and gifts for children of low income families. This program relies fully on donations from townships, businesses, churches. organizations, and individuals. After a family goes through the process to qualify, they supply a list of gifts, clothes and toys for the children, ages newborn to 18, wanted and needed. Shoppers help to fill the list within the monetary guidelines. The Toy and Gift program also gives away socks, toothbrushes and toothpaste, warm coats, hats, gloves, wrapping paper, tags, and bows.

How can you help make Christmas brighter for Piatt County families this year? Money is the easiest contribution. Martha is also collecting good, used winter coats in all sizes. (Remember that some kids are adult sized.) Another way to help is if you have received a "gift" that you will not use, bring it to the church and put it in the box that is designated for the Toy program. These could include shampoo, lotion, jewelry, unused children's toys, and of course winter hats and gloves. Last year gifts were provided to 100 children!
