Q: What is the goal of Kingdom Builders?


A: To give us a greater focus on how we can love like God does and have a greater kingdom impact in three areas: Global Missions, Local Church Outreach & Expansion and Future Generations.

Q: What is the difference between tithing and giving to Kingdom Builders?

A: Kingdom Builders does not replace tithing, it works alongside it. Tithing is 10% of your income that supports the mission of New Life. Kingdom Builders is giving above and beyond your tithe to help build the kingdom outside these walls; globally, locally, and with future generations.

Monthly Support of Global | \$16,640 Missionaries and Partners

New Life currently partners with 25 missionaries and organizations globally around the world and the United States representing over 20 countries and 5 continents. If God calls people to go, we are committed to sending them. Missionaries are the front lines of the Gospel in places we may never get to go. Our missionaries and partners rely on our monthly support as well as funding for special projects and resources.

59.9% of those who live in Grant County do not have a church they call home. With our various ways of giving and going locally, we aim to change that and help Jesus build His church right here in our own neighborhoods.

NL Facility Care \$30,000

To effectively reach out and care for our community, we must also care for the facility we want our community to come and call home like we do. These funds will be used to take care of facility needs that include roof repairs and replacement, carpet replacement, bathroom renovations, parking lot resurfacing, sidewalk repairs and more.

NL Outreaches \$9,000

Several times a year, we as a church choose to love on our community by providing high-quality, well-planned events that demonstrate our desire for those who live nearby to know Jesus loves them. In 2022, we plan to continue to adapt our outreaches to meet the needs of our community. Our 3 main outreaches include the Mega Million Egg Hunt, Drive-Thru Food Pantry & Backpack Giveaway, and Fallapalooza.

NL Cares | \$12,000

The past 2 years have continued to show us that care is not just important, it's necessary. NL Cares includes, but is not limited to, utility assistance for members of Grant County, meals for those going through various life transitions (births, deaths, surgeries, etc.), various care packages for those who call New Life home, and brand new for 2022 – Compassion Week.

Compassion Week (formerly our Boldly Go project)

At New Life, we believe it is far more important for us to be the church than just to go to church. To model this, we choose a week to partner with our community and go be the church by serving them. Compassion causes you to move to action and Compassion Week is all about loving Grant County as God does.

GCRM | \$5,000

The homeless, the hurting, and the hungry all can find hope and the life-saving message of Jesus Christ at the Grant County Rescue Mission (GCRM). New Life partners with the GCRM through volunteering our time but also the financial support of their various programs for men and women. mygcrm.org

Malleable Coffee | \$5,000 House/Café

We believe the west side of Marion is in need of more places to connect and build community. We purchased the brick building at 917 S Miller Ave and the surrounding land several years ago and now are pursuing how to turn that space into one of those connection/community building places. We have already received a grant that will match any funds we use, up to \$5,000, to create architectural renderings to visualize what we plan to create with that building and land.

Local Monthly Support for partners and non-profits \$1,680

New Life currently partners with 4 missionaries and organizations locally around Grant County and the state of Indiana. We love partnering with others who are doing good in our county and in our state. Our missionaries and partners rely on our monthly support as well as funding for special projects and resources.

In A Pinch | \$1,000

Residency, Internship, and Practicum Programs \$18,400

New Life is a unique place where college students can come to be loved, equipped, challenged, transformed, and fed. Since 2020, we have had 7 summer interns and 4 resident pastors who have served as pastors to Momentum Youth and online ministries. In 2022, we plan to add a resident pastor for NL Kids. This allows us to continue to take our commitment to invest into and impact future generation leaders to even greater levels.

Monthly Support for partners and non-profits reaching future generations

\$4,380

New Life currently partners with 7 missionaries in universities in Indiana and Illinois and 2 organizations locally in Grant County. We love partnering with others who believe in future generations as much as we do.

College Connection \$3,000

One of the hardest things for a young person to do is attend a college away from home. Not only do they need to make new friends, and learn new things, but they also need to find a church they can call home, while away from home. College Connection will help those students at Taylor University and Indiana Wesleyan University who come to New Life feel at home and get connected with others.

Next Gen Scholarships | \$3,000

These scholarships will be available to help college students, teenagers and kids of New Life with things like tuition, summer camp registration, and other costs we can help with to invest into their lives and assist them in their on-going journeys.

Boys and Girls Club \$1,000

The Boys & Girls Club of Grant County offers a variety of programs designed to benefit their members from tutoring, character development programs, athletic leagues, game room activities and open-court hours. They also team with US Foods and Americorps to better provide nutritious snacks and meals to their members.

How do we get to \$155,700?

- 10% of our annual tithe is placed into our Kingdom Builders fund.
- Those who call New Life home make commitments to give weekly, monthly or yearly to Kingdom Builders projects.
- In November, we will have a Miracle Offering Sunday to help finish and complete <u>2022</u> projects.
- We provide 2-4 additional giving opportunities each year to fund Kingdom Builders' projects (Usually around Easter, Mother's Day, Father's Day, and Christmas).
