### **Bethany Information About Our Local Scouts**

In recent weeks the Wisconsin Conference has reached out to all local churches with a directive regarding Scouting BSA and the Sponsor Charters that many of them have, Bethany included. As you may be aware, BSA filed for bankruptcy relief in early 2020. It is important to understand that stakeholders in the bankruptcy process include Chartered Organizations, which are the local churches, schools, and civic groups that sponsor or host a Scout Troop, Pack, Crew, or other unit. The Conference, out of concern for protecting assets, has asked all UMC churches to not renew Charters with their local Troops/Units. This directive is being given to all Methodist churches across the country.

As an Administrative Council we want to stress that we value our relationship with our local Troops and have high regard for those members that have been part of the Bethany troop for the past 40+ years. Bethany has also been the recipient of many beautiful Eagle Scout projects, the most recent being that fantastic fire pit!


