Every day, children come to school without their basic needs being met. Ashwaubenon Cares (or AshCares), has been established to provide families the opportunity to help each other.

AshCares is a network of people who receive notification via email when an Ashwaubenon student/family is in need. Items requested may be as simple as pants, shoes, winter boots, gloves, underwear, or socks. Sometimes larger items like beds and dressers are needed. 
Maggie Westbrook


Family S'more-gasbord
